MATERIALS

- 640-508 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Desert
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon; Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



GAUGE:

9 stitches = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Each Wrist Warmer is worked as a simple Garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row) rectangle.
2. Each rectangle is sewn into a tube, leaving an opening for thumb.

WRIST WARMERS (make 2)

Cast on 17 stitches.

Work in Garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row) until piece measures about 7 1/2 in. (19 cm) from beginning. Bind off, leaving a yarn tail about 18 in. (45.5

cm) long.

FINISHING

Thread the end of the yarn tail into the blunt needle.

Fold the piece, bringing the cast on edge to meet the bound off edge.

With the threaded blunt needle, sew the edges together, leaving a 2 in. (5 cm) opening for thumb.

Weave in yarn ends.
