# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Color Clouds

### Lakewood Cowl

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 26 in. (66 cm)

**Finished Height** About 13 in. (33 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 546-098 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Travelers Tan  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size Q-19 (15mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

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#### GAUGE:

4 sc + 3 ch-1 sps = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 2 and 3.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

Cowl is worked back and forth in rows, then twisted and seamed to make a twisted (Mobius) loop.

#### COWL

Ch 20.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc in next ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* across to last st, sc in last sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, sk next sc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* across to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next sc, sc in last sc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until about 10 in. (25.5 cm) of yarn remains.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Lay Cowl onto a flat surface. Pick up one short end and turn it over, making a twist in Cowl. Taking care not to undo the twist, thread yarn tail into blunt needle and sew short ends of Cowl together.

Weave in yarn ends.
