- 640-154 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Grey Marble</u>
   1 Ball (A)
- 640-503 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Granite</u>

   Ball (B)
- 640-505 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Marble</u> 1 Ball (C)
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size</u>
   13 [9 mm]
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool:

Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool: 8% Rayon:

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)

Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



#### **GAUGE:**

10 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Checks pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

Checks pattern (worked over a multiple of 6 sts + 3 additional sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

**Rows 2 and 4:** P3, \*k3, p3; rep from \* to end of row. **Rows 3 and 5:** K3, \*p3, k3; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 6: Purl.

**Rows 7 and 9:** P3, \*k3, p3; rep from \* to end of row. **Rows 8 and 10:** K3, \*p3, k3; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-10 for Checks pattern.

### **NOTES:**

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece, changing stitch patterns and yarn colors.
- 2. When changing yarn color, leave long yarn tails to weave in later.

#### **SCARF**

With A, cast on 22 stitches.

### Ribbed end of Scarf

**Row 1:** K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 4 1/2 in. (cm) from beg, end after working a Row 2.

Change to B.

Next Row: With B, rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 6 1/2 in. (cm) from beg, end after working a Row 1.

**Next Row:** With B, p10, p2tog, p to end of row – you will have 21 sts.

**Next Row:** With B, work Row 1 of Checks pattern across.

With B, continue in Checks pattern until you have finished Row 10, then rep Rows 1-5 of Checks pattern once more. Change to A.

With A, work Rows 6-10 of Checks pattern, then work Rows 1-5.

Change to C.

With C, work Rows 6-10 of Checks pattern, then work Rows 1-10 twice, Rows 1-5 once more.

Change to B.

With B, work Rows 6-10 of Checks pattern, then work Rows 1-10 once, Rows 1-5 once more.

Change to A.

With A, work Rows 6-10 of Checks pattern, then work Rows 1-10 for 4 times.

Change to C.

With C, work Rows 1-10 of Checks pattern twice, then Rows 1-5 once more.

Change to B.

With B, work Rows 6-10 of Checks pattern, then work Rows 1-10 once.

Change to A.

With A, work Rows 1-10 of Checks pattern.

Change to B.

With B, work Rows 1-5 of Checks pattern.

#### Seed st end of Scarf

Row 1: With B, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 until only about 1 yd.

(1 m) of B remains.

Bind off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in yarn ends.
