**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 24 in. (60 cm)

**MATERIALS**

- 497-asstd Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon 1 Ball *\*LB Collection Silk Chiffon Ribbon (Article #497). 100% silk; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (90yds/82m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Circular knitting needle size 17 (12 mm), 24 in. (60 cm) long



**GAUGE:**

8 1/2 stitches = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Cowl pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

**COWL**

Loosely cast on 52 stitches. Place marker for beg of round. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Ribbed Edge**

**Rounds 1 and 2:** \*Knit 2, purl 2; repeat from \* around.

**Rounds 3-24:** Knit.

**Ribbed Edge**

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2.

Bind off loosely.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
