MATERIALS

- 135-216 Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Anchorage Ice
2 Balls (A) **Hometown USA (Article #135). Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: Solids: 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m)*
- 861-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Onyx
1 Ball (B) **Vanna's Glamour (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 6 [4.00 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

11 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Seeded Rib Check with larger needles and A.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seeded Rib Check (worked over a multiple of 4 sts + an additional 3 sts)

Row 1: K3, *p1, k3; rep from * across.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k3; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rows 3 and 5: Rep Row 1.

Rows 4 and 6: Rep Row 2.

Rows 7, 9 and 11: Rep Row 2.
Rows 8, 10 and 12: Rep Row 1.
Rep Rows 1-12 for Seeded Rib Check.

NOTES:

The A yarn section of Cowl is worked in Seeded Rib Check, then sts for the B section of Cowl are picked up along one edge.



COWL

With larger needles and A, cast on 23 sts.

Work Rows 1-12 of Seeded Rib Check for a total of 9 times.

Bind off.

From RS, with smaller needle and B, pick up and k 50 sts evenly spaced across cast on end of Cowl. We picked up in both the front and the back loop of the cast on sts.

Beginning with a WS (purl) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until B section measures about 11 in. (28 cm).

FINISHING

Sew bound off end of B section of Cowl to bound off end of A section.

With B threaded into blunt needle, work straight sts across top edge of B section. Pull to gather and knot securely.

Bring bound off and cast on ends of A section together, enclosing the B section. Sew ends together at top and for about 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) down from top edge.

Weave in ends.
