# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Tonal

### Blue Bobble Hat

Pattern Number: L50304

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Apr 5, 2016)

#### GAUGE

~~5 (sc, 2 dc) groups = about 4 in. (10 cm)~~ 3 (sc, 2 dc) groups = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

#### MATERIALS

- 635-105 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Caribbean Blue  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

3 (sc, 2 dc) groups = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**6-dc Cl (6 double crochet cluster)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 5 times (7 loops rem on hook), yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

**dc2tog (dc 2 sts together)** (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in joined and turned rnds.
2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 50, 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st), \*sk next 2 ch, (sc, 2 dc) in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk last 2 ch, taking care not

to twist row, sc in same ch as first 2 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – you will have 16 (sc, 2 dc) groups at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.  
3. Bobbles are worked separately, then sewn to top of Hat.

## HAT

Ch 48; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (does not count as a st in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in same ch as joining, \*sk next 2 ch, (sc, 2 dc) in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, sk last 2 ch, sc in same ch as first 2 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – you will have 16 (sc, 2 dc) groups at the end of this rnd.

**Rnds 2-13:** Ch 2, turn, 2 dc in first sc, \*sk next 2 sts, (sc, 2 dc) in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sk last 2 sts, sc in same sc as first 2 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

**Shape Crown (top of Hat) Rnd 14:** Ch 2, turn, \*sk next st, dc2tog; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 16 dc.

**Rnd 15:** Ch 1, turn, \*sc2tog; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch-1 – 8 sc.

**Rnd 16:** Ch 1, turn, \*sc2tog; rep from \* around; join with sl st in beg ch-1 – 4 sc.

Fasten off. Do not close opening at top of Hat.

## BOBBLES (make 9)

Ch 3, 6-dc Cl in 3rd ch from hook, ch 1, sl st in same ch, ch 10.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Draw the Bobble chains through the opening at top of Hat.

Use yarn tails to sew ends of chains to WS of Hat.

Weave in yarn ends.
