Cardi

Finished Chest About 22 (24, 26) in. (56 (61, 66) cm)

Finished Length About 11 (12, 13) in. (28 (30.5, 33) cm), not including collar

Hat

Finished Circumference About 17 1/2 in. (44.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

Sewing needle and thread



GAUGE:

19 1/2 sts + 40 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit into front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st -1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES:

1. Cardi is made in 5 pieces: Back, 2 Fronts and 2 Sleeves. The collar is worked directly onto the Cardi.

2. The yarn color is changed to make stripes.
3. For the Hat, 2 flaps are worked separately, then joined to finish the Hat.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

*Work 6 rows with A, 6 rows with B; rep from * for Stripe Sequence.

CARDI

BACK

With A, cast on 54 (58, 64) sts.


Work in Garter st (k every row), changing color every 6 rows following Stripe Sequence, until piece measures about 11 (12, 13) in. (28 (30.5, 33) cm) from beg.

Shape Shoulders

Next Row: Bind off 16 (18, 20) sts, k to end of row – 38 (40, 44) sts.

Next Row: Bind off 16 (18, 20) sts, k to end of row – 22 (22, 24) sts.

Place rem 22 (22, 24) sts onto a holder for collar.



LEFT FRONT

With A, cast on 32 (34, 38) sts.

Work in Garter st, changing color every 6 rows following Stripe Sequence, for 20 rows.

Continue to change color following Stripe Sequence until Left Front is complete.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K to last 5 sts, yo, k2tog, k to end of row.

Work in Garter st for 13 (15, 17) rows.

Rep Buttonhole Row.

Rep last 14 (16, 18) rows 2 more times.

Work in Garter st until piece measures same as Back to shoulders, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row (RS): Bind off 16 (18, 20) sts, k to end of row – 16 (16, 18) sts.

Place rem 16 (16, 18) sts onto a holder for collar.


RIGHT FRONT

Cast on and work in Garter st, changing color every 6 rows following Stripe Sequence, until piece measures same as Back to shoulders, end with a RS row as the last row you work.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row (WS): Bind off 16 (18, 20) sts, k to end of row – 16 (16, 18) sts.

Place rem 16 (16, 18) sts onto a holder for collar.



SLEEVES (make 2)

With A, cast on 32 (34, 36) sts.

Work in Garter st, changing color every 6 rows following Stripe Sequence, for 6 rows.

Continue to change color following Stripe Sequence until Sleeve is complete.


Increase Row: K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – 34 (36, 38) sts.

Work in Garter st for 5 rows.

Rep last 6 rows 5 (7, 9) times – 44 (50, 56) sts when all increases have been completed.

Work in Garter st until piece measures about 5 1/2 (7, 8 1/2) in. (14 (18, 21.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.



FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Collar

From RS, with A and working across sts on holders, k16 (16, 18) right front collar sts, k22 (22, 24) back collar sts, and k16 (16, 18) left front collar sts – 54 (54, 60) sts.

Work in Garter st, changing color every 6 rows following Stripe Sequence, for 23 rows.

Bind off.

Sew in Sleeves.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to right front opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.

HAT

First Flap

With A, cast on 28 sts.

Work in Garter st, changing color following Stripe Sequence for 12 rows.

Slip these 28 sts onto a holder.

Second Flap

Cast on and work as for First Flap, but do not slip sts to a holder.

Body

Note: Continue to change color following Stripe Sequence until Hat is complete.

Next Row: K28 sts of second flap, cast on 30 sts, k28 sts from holder for first flap – 86 sts.

Work in Garter st for 29 rows.

Shape Top of Hat

Next Row: K1, *place marker, k14; rep from * 5 more times, k1.

Decrease Row: *K to marker, slip marker, k2tog; rep from * 5 more times, k to end of row – 80 sts.


Rep last 2 rows 6 more times, slipping markers as you come to them – 44 sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next 3 Rows: Knit, slipping markers as you come to them.

Rep Decrease Row – 38 sts.

Rep last 4 rows 5 more times – 8 sts when all decreases have been completed.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and through remaining sts. Pull to gather top of Hat and sew seam including flaps.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.
