MATERIALS

- 136-105 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

Heartland (Article #136). **Solids: 100% Acrylic
Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size:
Solids: 5oz/142g (251yd/230m)
Tweeds: 4oz/113g (200yd/183m)*



GAUGE:

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-6 of pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Wrap with one sleeve is worked in one piece, then divided to shape the neck.
2. Sleeve cuff is worked from stitches picked up along the lower edge of the sleeve.
3. Rib at neck is worked separately, then sewed to Wrap.



WRAP

Cast on 77 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *P6, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: * P2, k5; rep from * to end of row.

Row 3: * P4, k3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 4: * P4, k3; rep from * to end of row.

Row 5: * P2, k5; rep from * to end of row.

Row 6: * P6, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep Rows 1-6 until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg.

Neck Opening

Dividing Row: Work in pattern as established across 35 sts; join a 2nd ball of yarn and bind off next 7 sts, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Working both sides AT THE SAME TIME with separate balls of yarn, continue in pattern as established until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from beg.

Joining Row: Work in pattern across 35 sts of first side, cast on 7 sts; with same ball of yarn, work in pattern across 35 sts of 2nd side – 77 sts.

Cut 2nd ball of yarn.

Continue in pattern as established until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Cuff

Cast on 6 sts, then pick up and k 82 sts evenly spaced across cast-on edge of piece, then cast on 6 sts – 94 sts.

Row 1 (WS): P1, *k2, p2; rep from * to last st, p1.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 until cuff measures about 2 in. (2.5 cm).

Bind off.

Sew side edges of cuff together.

Neckband

Cast on 108 sts.

Row 1 (RS): *K2, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

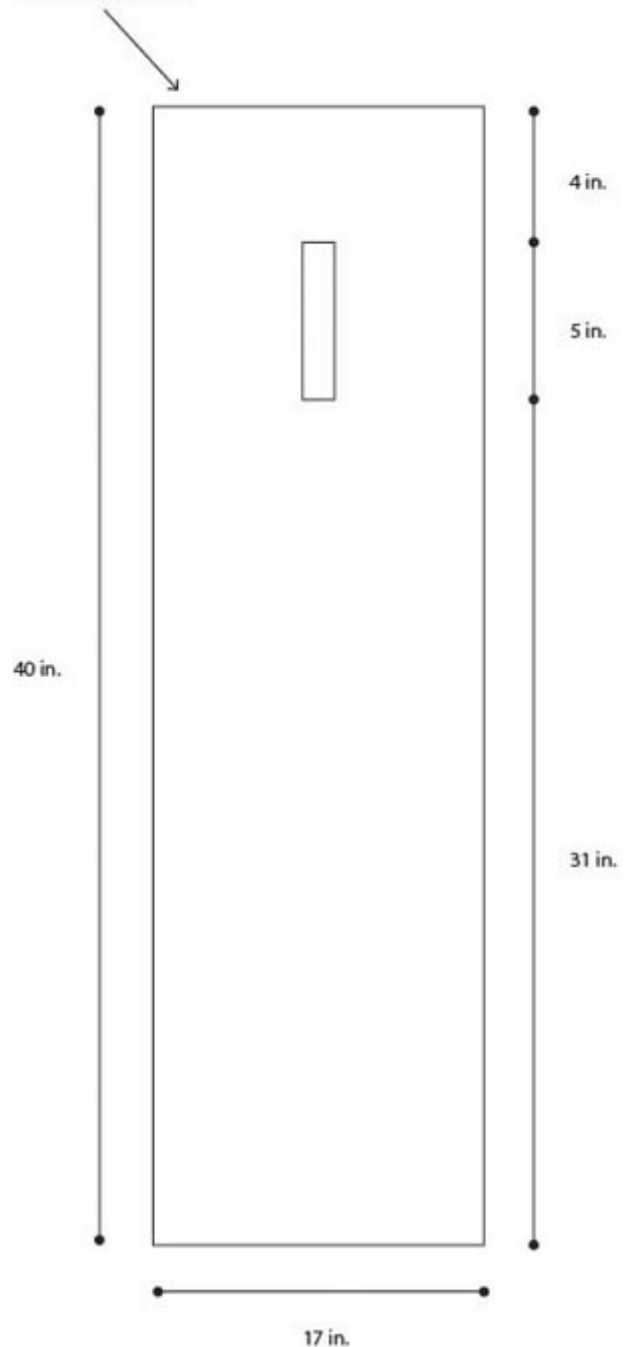
Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 1 in. (5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

Sew side edges of neckband together to make a ring. Sew neckband to neck opening.

Weave in ends.

Pick up sts for cuff along this edge
