SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height About 7 in. (18 cm)

MATERIALS

- 135-216 Lion Brand Hometown USA

Yarn: Anchorage Ice

1 Ball (A)

- 135-189 Lion Brand Hometown USA

Yarn: Napa Valley Pinot

1 Ball (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13
(9 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles
(Set of 6)

- Additional Materials

Purchased feathers and beads as desired

Sewing needle and thread

Hometown USA (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, **Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) **Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

9 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in joined rnds.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
3. All embellishments are optional. Pattern is for a classic hat that will look great on its own or embellished as you like!

HAT

With A, ch 2.

Set-up Rnd: Work 6 sc in first ch; join with sl st in first sc – 6 sc.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join with a sl st in first sc – 12 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 30 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 36 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 5 sc, sc in last 5 sc, changing to B in last st; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc.

Rnd 7: With B, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc through the back loop in each st around; join with sl st in first hdc – 42 hdc.

Rnds 8-15: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), hdc in each hdc around, changing to A in last st; join with sl st in first hdc.

Rnd 16: With A, ch 1, sc in first 5 hdc, *sc2tog, sc in next 5 hdc; rep from * to last 2 hdc, sc2tog; join with sl st in first sc – 36 hdc.

Rnds 17 and 18: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, *2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc; rep from * to last sc, 2 sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

With sewing needle and thread, sew beads and feathers to Hat as desired.
