 635-154 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Tonal: Grey Marble</u>

 1 Ball (A)

• 635-105 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease</u> <u>Tonal: Caribbean Blue</u>

1 Ball (B)

 <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size</u> K-10.5 (6.5 mm)

- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
 Purchased feather and jewelry decorations as desired
 Sewing needle and thread

*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

11 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice. Yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

- 1. Hat is worked in one piece in joined rnds.
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Proceed with new color Fasten off old color.
- 3. All embellishments are optional. Pattern is for a classic hat that will look good on its own or embellished as you like!

HAT

With A, ch 2.

Set-up Rnd: Work 6 sc in first ch; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc – 12 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last sc, sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 18 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with sl st in the sc - 24 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 30 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 36 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 5 sc, sc in last 5 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 6 sc, sc in last 6 sc; join with sl st in the first sc - 48 sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, *sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 7 sc, sc in last 7 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 54 sc.

Rnds 9-17: Ch 1, sc in each sc around; changing to B in last st of last rnd; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 18-22: With B, ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

With sewing needle and thread, sew feathers and jewelry trim to Hat as desired.
