MATERIALS• 231-152 Lion Brand Gold

Leaf: Black/Silver

1 Ball (A)

 231-149 <u>Lion Brand Gold</u> <u>Leaf: Grey/Silver</u>
 1 Ball (B)

 <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook</u> -Size N-13 (9 mm)

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u> Blunt Needles (Set of 6) *Gold Leaf (Article #231). 90% Acrylic, 10% Wool, Exclusive of Decoration; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr. (49yds/45m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

8 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Hat is worked in one piece in joined rnds, beg at top of Hat.
- 2. Read the pattern carefully! Work is turned at the beg of some rnds and not turned at the beg of other rnds.
- 3. Body of Hat is worked with A, the brim is worked with B.

HAT

Make an adjustable ring as follows: Wrap A around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop.> Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull yarn tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 11 more dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc.

Rnd 2 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), do NOT turn, dc in same st as joining, 2 dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc.

Rnd 3 (WS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in next st, *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, *hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 42 hdc.

Rnds 6-8: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2. Fasten off.

Brim

Rnd 9 (WS): From WS, draw up a loop of B in same st as joining, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2.

Rnd 10 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, *hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 56 hdc.

Rnd 11 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), do NOT turn, working in back loops only, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, *hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch-2 – 70 hdc.

Rnds 12 and 13: Ch 1, do NOT turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Cord

Cut two 40 in. (101.5 cm) strands each of A and B. Knot the strands tog about 2 in. (5 cm) from one end. Twist the strands together, then knot about 2 in. (5 cm) from the opposite end.

Weave cord in and out of the spaces between the sts of Rnd 8. Knot ends, then tie into a bow.
