SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Height About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 595-215 Lion Brand Color Waves: Twilight
1 Ball
 - Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 8
 - Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
 - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- *Color Waves (Article #595). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (306yds/280m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern Rows 8-20

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left hand needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round on double-pointed needles beginning at lower edge.
2. A twisted rib is worked at the lower edge of the Hat. To work twisted rib, work all knit sts through the back loop.
3. The body of the Hat is worked in an easy pattern that creates an interesting, sculptural effect.

HAT

Cast on 84 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles with 21 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-6: *K1 through back loop, p1; rep from * around.

Rnd 7 (Increase Rnd): *P14, M1; rep from * around – you will have 90 sts at the end of this rnd.

Note: On Rnds 8-20, you will be working the same number of decreases and increases on each rnd, so the st count will remain the same.

Rnd 8: *P12, p2tog, k1, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 9: *P11, p2tog, k2, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 10: *P10, p2tog, k3, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 11: *P9, p2tog, k4, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 12: *P8, p2tog, k5, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 13: *P7, p2tog, k6, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 14: *P6, p2tog, k7, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 15: *P5, p2tog, k8, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 16: *P4, p2tog, k9, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 17: *P3, p2tog, k10, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 18: *P2, p2tog, k11, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 19: *P1, p2tog, k12, M1; rep from * around.
Rnd 20: *P2tog, k13, M1; rep from * around.

Rep Rnds 8-20 for 3 more times.

Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Decrease Rnd 1: *P12, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 84 sts.
Decrease Rnd 2: *P11, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 78 sts.
Decrease Rnd 3: *P10, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 72 sts.
Decrease Rnd 4: *P9, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 66 sts.
Decrease Rnd 5: *P8, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 60 sts.
Decrease Rnd 6: *P7, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 54 sts.
Decrease Rnd 7: *P6, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 48 sts.
Decrease Rnd 8: *P5, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 42 sts.
Decrease Rnd 9: *P4, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 36 sts.
Decrease Rnd 10: *P3, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 30 sts.
Decrease Rnd 11: *P2, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 24 sts.
Decrease Rnd 12: *P1, p2tog, k1; rep from * around – 18 sts.
Decrease Rnd 13: *P2tog, k1; rep from * around – 12 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
