SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

MATERIALS

- 635-189 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Cabernet
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

5 1/2 pattern reps + 7 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep consists of an esc2tog and the following ch-1 sp.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

esc2tog (esc 2 sts together) Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (first leg made), insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (2nd leg made), yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased. **Note:** This st is always worked over the next sc, esc2tog or esc2tog-over-3 and the following ch-1 sp.

esc2tog-over-3 (esc 2 sts together worked over 3 sts) Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (first leg made), sk next ch-1 sp, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (2nd leg made), yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased. **Note:** This st is always worked over the next 2 sc, esc2tog or esc2tog-over-3, skipping the ch-1 sp between them.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

Adjustable Ring

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 (in pattern, below) into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in joined and turned rnds.
2. When working into an esc2tog insert hook between the 2 legs instead of in the top of the st.
3. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 55, beg in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch do not count as a st), esc2tog, *ch 1, esc2tog; rep from * to last ch, ch 1, sc in last ch; join with sl st in beg ch-2 – you will have 26 esc2tog, 1 sc, and 26 ch-1 sps (for a total of 53 sts) at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.
4. Flower is worked separately, then sewn to Hat.

HAT

Ch 53; join with a sl st in first ch to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st in this rnd and in all following rnds), esc2tog,*ch 1, esc2tog; rep from * to last ch, ch 1, sc in last ch; join with sl st in beg ch-2 – you will have 26 pattern reps (26 esc2tog, 1 sc, and 26 ch-1 sps, for a total of 53 sts) at the end of this rnd.

Rnds 2-10: Ch 2, turn, esc2tog, *ch 1, esc2tog; rep from * to last st, ch 1, sc in last st; join with sl st in beg ch-2.

Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Rnd 11: Ch 2, turn, *(esc2tog, ch 1) 3 times, esc2tog-over-3, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 3 sts, esc2tog, ch 1, sc in last st; join with sl st in beg ch-2 – 21 pattern reps (21 esc2tog, 1 sc, and 21 ch-1 sps, for a total of 43 sts).

Rnd 12: Ch 2, turn, (esc2tog, ch 1) twice, *esc2tog-over-3, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (esc2tog, ch 1) 3 times, esc2tog-over-3, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (esc2tog, ch 1) twice; rep from * to last 3 sts, esc2tog, ch 1, sc in last st; join with sl st in beg ch-2 – 17 pattern reps (17 esc2tog, 1 sc, and 17 ch-1 sps, for a total of 35 sts).

Rnd 13: Ch 2, turn, *esc2tog-over-3, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 3 sts, esc2tog, ch 1, sc in last st; join with sl st in beg ch-2 – 9 pattern reps (9 esc2tog, 1 sc, and 9 ch-1 sps, for a total of 19 sts).

Rnd 14: Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 9 times, sc in last st; join with sl st in beg ch-1 – 10 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through top of sts of last rnd and pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FLOWER

Make an adjustable ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, 9 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc – you will have 9 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 5, sc in same sc as joining, (sl st, ch 5, sc) in each of next 8 sc – 9 sc and 9 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 3: Working behind ch-5 sps and into Rnd 1 sts (same sts as were worked into in Rnd 2), (sl st, ch 7, sc) in each st of Rnd 1 – 9 sc and 9 ch-7 sps.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew flower to Hat.

Weave in ends.
