# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Vanna's Palettes Puebla Scarf

Pattern Number: L50344

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 7 1/2 x 66 in. (19 x 167.5 cm), not including fringe

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Jun 16, 2016)

### SCARF

With yarn color of your choice, ch 26.

When working Row 1, refer to diagram to clarify the 3rd ch from hook.

### FINISHING

#### Fringe

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Add fringe along edge of Scarf as desired.

### MATERIALS

- 865-203 Lion Brand Vanna's Palettes: Earthy  
1 Ball *\*Vanna's Palettes (Article #865). 100% Acrylic; package size: 0.35oz/10.00 gr. (17yds/16m) pull skeins*
- 865-204 Lion Brand Vanna's Palettes: Charming  
1 Ball
- 865-206 Lion Brand Vanna's Palettes: Iconic  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



### GAUGE:

13 hdc through back loop = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### Making a Gauge Swatch

### NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, changing color to make stripes.
2. All yarn colors are used 'as desired'.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and

draw through all loops to complete the stitch, then fasten off the old color.  
4. When changing color, leave 4 in. (10 cm) long yarn tails - these yarn tails will become fringes. Additional fringes can be added to the completed Scarf if desired.

## SCARF

With yarn color of your choice, ch 26.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), and in each ch across – 25 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, working THROUGH BACK LOOPS ONLY, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 2, changing yarn color as desired and always working either 2 or 4 rows with a color (this is so that your yarn tails will all be on the same side of your Scarf).

Work until Scarf is about 66 in. (167.5 cm) long.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Fringe

For each fringe, cut an 8 in. (20.5 cm) long strand of yarn.

Fold strand in half. With crochet hook, draw fold through edge of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Add fringe along edge of Scarf as desired.
