SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

MATERIALS

• 595-217 <u>Lion Brand Color</u> <u>Waves: Ocean Drive</u> 1 Ball

- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles-</u> Size 8 [5 mm]
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Color Waves</u> (Article #595). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (306yds/280m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

18 sts + 32 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left hand needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

NOTES:

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece.
- 2. One end of the Scarf is shaped with increases and a slit is worked on the opposite end to create styling options.
- 3. To work the slit, you will need to wind yarn into 2 separate balls before beginning.

SCARF

Cast on 10 sts.

Knit 3 rows.

Next Row (Increase Row): K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 – you will have 12 sts at the end of this row. Rep last 4 rows until you have 36 sts.

Continue in Garter st (knit every st on every row) until piece measures about 29 in. (73.5 cm) from beginning.

Divide for Slit

Next Row: K18, join a second ball of yarn and k to end of row.

Working both sides AT THE SAME TIME with separate balls of yarn, continue in Garter st for 19 more rows.

Joining Row: Knit across all sts on both sides with the same ball of yarn to join. Cut second ball of yarn, leaving a yarn tail to weave in later.

Continue in Garter st until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from Joining Row. Bind off.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends.
