# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Tonal

### Sangria Vest

Pattern Number: L50294

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Width** About 35 in. (89 cm), at widest point

**Finished Length** About 32 in. (81.5 cm), from back neck to lowest point

#### MATERIALS

- 635-145 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease](#)  
Tonal: Plum  
3 Balls (A) \*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;  
package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins
- 635-189 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease](#)  
Tonal: Cabernet  
1 Ball (B)
- 635-112 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease](#)  
Tonal: Raspberry  
1 Ball (C)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook](#) -  
Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt](#)  
Needles (Set of 6)



#### GAUGE:

10 sts + 4 1/2 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern. **Note:** Each Cl, dc, and ch count as 1 st.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Cl (2 double crochet cluster)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook), yarn over, insert hook in *same* st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.


**rev sc (reverse single crochet)** Single crochet worked from left to right (right to left, if left-handed). Insert hook into next stitch to the right (left), under loop on hook, and draw up a loop. Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

#### NOTES:

1. Vest is worked in one piece in joined rnds with RS always facing.
2. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and draw up a loop of the new color in any corner ch-sp.

## VEST

With A, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), (dc, ch 1, dc) in ring, \*ch 2, (dc, ch 1, dc) in ring; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, dc in ring, ch 1; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch – you will have 10 dc, 5 ch-1 sps, and 5 ch-2 sps at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in first ch-2 sp, ch 2, dc in same ch-2 sp (beg ch-2 and first dc count as first cluster in this rnd and all following rnds), ch 2, Cl in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), \*ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (Cl, ch 2, Cl) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from \* 3 more times, ch 1, 2 dc in last ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 10 dc, 10 clusters, 10 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-2 sps (2 dc and 2 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between (Cl, ch 2, Cl) corners).

**Rnd 3:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-2 sp, \*dc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next st, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in last st; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 20 dc, 10 clusters, 10 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (4 dc and 2 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between (Cl, ch 3, Cl) corners).

**Rnd 4:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) twice, ch 1, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) twice, ch 1; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 30 dc, 10 clusters, 20 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (6 dc and 4 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

**Rnd 5:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-3 sp, \*dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to ch-1 sp before next corner, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next st, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in last st; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 40 dc, 10 clusters, 20 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (8 dc and 4 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

**Rnd 6:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 50 dc, 10 clusters, 30 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (10 dc and 6 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 7:** From RS, draw up a loop of B in any corner ch-3 sp, (ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in same corner ch-3 sp, \*dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to ch-1 sp before next corner, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next st, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in last st; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 60 dc, 10 clusters, 30 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (12 dc and 6 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 8:** From RS, draw up a loop of A in any corner ch-3 sp, (ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in same corner ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in

top of first cluster – 70 dc, 10 clusters, 40 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (14 dc and 8 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 9:** With C, rep Rnd 7 – 80 dc, 10 clusters, 40 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (16 dc and 8 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 10:** With A, rep Rnd 8 – 90 dc, 10 clusters, 50 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (18 dc and 10 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

#### Make Armholes

**Rnd 11:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-3 sp, \*dc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts, ch 25 for underarm, sk to next corner, dc in first Cl of corner, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in corner ch-3 sp, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to ch-1 sp before next corner, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next st, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* once more, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, dc in last st; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 68 dc, 10 clusters, 30 ch-1 sps, 5 corner ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-25 underarms (20 dc and 10 ch-1 sps on each of 3 sides between corners, 4 dc and ch-25 underarm ch on each of 2 sides between corners).

**Rnd 12:** (Sl st, ch 2, dc, ch 3, Cl) in first corner ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts; working across underarm ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next 2 ch) 8 times, ch 1, sk last ch, dc in next 2 sts, ch 1, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* once more, ch 1, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next 2 sts) to end of rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in top of first cluster – 110 dc, 10 clusters, 60 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (22 dc and 12 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnds 13-16:** Rep Rnds 7-10 – 150 dc, 10 clusters, 80 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (30 dc and 16 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners) at the end of Rnd 16.

Do not fasten off at the end of Rnd 16.

**Rnds 17 and 18:** With A, rep Rnds 5 and 6 – 170 dc, 10 clusters, 90 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (34 dc and 18 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners) at the end of Rnd 18.

Fasten off.

**Rnds 19 and 20:** Rep Rnds 7 and 8 – 190 dc, 10 clusters, 100 ch-1 sps and 5 corner ch-3 sps (38 dc and 20 ch-1 sps on each of 5 sides between corners) at the end of Rnd 20.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 21:** From RS, draw up a loop of C in any corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (rev sc, ch 2, rev sc) in same ch-3 sp, \*(ch 2, rev sc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 2, (rev sc, ch 2, rev sc) in corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 3 more times, (ch 2, rev sc in next ch-1 sp) to end of rnd, ch 2; join with sl st in beg ch-1.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Armhole Edging

**Note:** To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

From RS, draw up a loop of B in first ch-1 sp of either armhole so that you are ready to work along the back edge of the armhole, ch 1, rev sc in same ch-1 sp, \*ch 2, rev sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to end of back edge of armhole and change to C in last st; working across opposite side of underarm ch along front edge of armhole, \*\*ch 2, rev sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \*\* to end of armhole, ch 2; join with sl st in beg ch-1.

Fasten off.

Rep around 2nd armhole opening.

Weave in ends.
