MATERIALS

- 635-144 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Amethyst](#)
1 Ball (A)
*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;
package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins
- 635-126 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Coffee](#)
1 Ball (B)
- 635-105 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Caribbean Blue](#)
1 Ball (C)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials
Crochet hook size L-11 (8 mm)



GAUGE:

1 pattern rep + 5 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). **Note:** 1 pattern rep consists of 5 dc, the following ch-1 sp, dc, and next ch-1 sp.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

Surface Slip Stitch

1. From RS, join yarn with a sl st in first skipped ch of foundation ch.
2. Insert hook from RS to WS through ch-space in Rnd 1, yarn over, draw loop through loop on hook (surface sl st made).
3. *Lengthen loop on hook to reach ch-sp of next rnd immediately above, insert hook from RS to WS through ch-sp of next rnd, yarn over, draw loop through loop on hook (surface sl st made); rep from * to work a surface sl st in each ch-sp all the way to the top of the Cowl (Rnd 12).
4. Fasten off.

NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked in one piece in joined and turned rnds, changing color to form stripes.
2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row, then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 130, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count

as first dc), dc in next dc, *(ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, dc in next 4 ch; rep from * to last 5 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, dc in last ch; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have 16 pattern reps at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

3. To change color, fasten off old color. Draw up a loop of new color in same st as joining. Proceed with new color.

4. Vertical surface slip st lines are worked into the ch-sps of Cowl. Fringes are made along lower edge of Cowl.

COWL

With B, ch 128; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist ch.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 2 ch, *(ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, dc in next 4 ch; rep from * to last 5 ch, (ch 1, sk next ch, dc in next ch) twice, dc in last ch; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have 16 pattern reps at the end of this rnd (for a total of 96 dc and 32 ch-1 sps).

Change to C.

Rnd 2: With C, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 2 dc, *(ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, dc in next 4 dc; rep from * to last 2 ch-1 sps, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) twice, dc in last dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Change to A.

Rnds 3-5: With A, rep Rnd 2 three times.

Change to B.

Rnd 6: With B, rep Rnd 2.

Change to C.

Rnd 7: With C, rep Rnd 2.

Change to A.

Rnds 8-12: Rep Rnds 3-7.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Surface Slip Stitch

Following Technique Explanation, work lines of surface slip stitch into ch-sps from Rnd 1 to Rnd 12, alternating B and C.

Fringe

Cut 32 strands each of A, B and C, about 8 in. (20.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 2 strands of same color yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of last rnd on Cowl, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Working around the top edge of the Cowl, make an A fringe in the center dc of each 5-dc group. Make a B fringe at the end of each B line and a C fringe at the end of each C line.

Trim fringes evenly.
