# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Tonal

### Sun And Shade Ribbed Hat

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 18 in. (45.5 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

**Finished Height** About 11 in. (28 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 635-187 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Buttercup](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 635-149 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Smoke](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 16 inches Size 8](#)
- [Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 8](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts + 17 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm), following gauge swatch instructions.

**To work gauge swatch (worked flat over an even number of sts):**

You can use 2 double-pointed needles for your swatch, or work back and forth in rows on the circular needle. Cast on 16 sts and purl one row.

**Row 1:** \*P1, knit next stitch in the row below; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

Rep Row 1 until piece measures about 5 in. (13 cm).

Bind off.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**sk2p** Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over – 2 sts decreased.

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right hand needle; insert left hand needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round.
2. When changing colors, do NOT twist the yarns, just drop the old color and begin working with the new

color.

3. Hat is designed to be reversible - just weave in the yarn ends neatly!

## **HAT**

With circular needle and A, loosely cast on 40 sts. Place a marker for beginning of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 2:** With A, \*k next st in rnd below, p1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 3:** With B, \*k1, purl next st in rnd below; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnds 2 and 3 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg, ending with a Rnd 3 as the last rnd you work.

**Next Rnd:** With A, \*(k next st in rnd below, p1) 5 times, place marker (pm); rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Note:** Beg of rnd marker will be your last marker.

### **Shape Crown (top of Hat)**

**First Decrease Rnd:** With B, \*sk2p, p next st in rnd below, (k1, p next st in rnd below) to next marker, slip marker (sm); rep from \* around - 32 sts.

**Rnd 2:** With A, \*k next st in rnd below (into sk2p), p1, (k next st in rnd below, p1) to next marker, sm; rep from \* to end of rnd.

**Rnd 3:** With B, \*k1, p next st in rnd below; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 4:** With A, \*k next st in rnd below, p1; rep from \* around.

Transfer sts to 4 double-pointed needles as follows:

**Second Decrease Rnd:** With first double-pointed needle and B, \*sk2p, (p next st in rnd below, k1) twice, p next st in rnd below, remove marker; with each of the next 3 double-pointed needles, rep from \* around, do NOT remove beg of rnd marker - 6 sts on each needle.

Rep Rnds 2-4.

**Third Decrease Rnd:** With B, \*sk2p, p next st in rnd below, k1, p next st in rnd below - 4 sts on each needle.

Rep Rnds 2-4.

**Fourth Decrease Rnd:** With B, \*sk2p, p next st in rnd below; rep from \* around - 2 sts on each needle.

Cut B.

**Last Rnd:** With A, ssk around.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining 4 sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in yarn ends.
