### 3 Strand Grande Shawl

88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size:  
8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins*

#### **MATERIALS**

- 792-213 Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick: Antique Stripes  
4 Balls (A)
- 790-309 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Deco  
2 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Super Circs - Circular Knitting Needles Size 50 (25 mm) 45" (114 cm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic,  
2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00  
gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

4 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2 of Shawl pattern with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held together.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **NOTES:**

1. Shawl is worked in one piece with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B (3 strands total) held together in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every row) borders.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large stitches. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
3. As you knit, be sure to always work the sts through all 3 strands.

#### **SHAWL**

With 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B held together, cast on 24 sts.

##### **Beginning Border**

Knit 6 rows for Garter st border.

**Row 1 (WS):** K3 (for Garter st side border), p to last 3 sts (for St st center of Afghan), k3 (for Garter st side border).

**Row 2:** Knit.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 71 in. (180.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 1 as the last row you work.

**Ending Border**

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
