*<u>Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (</u>Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;

Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon;

Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon;

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

- 1. The Wall Hanging is meant to inspire your creativity! Follow the row by row instructions to make the Hanging, though you needn't follow the pattern exactly. The diagram provides an overview of the piece.
- 2. To change yarn color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail. Begin weaving with the new color, leaving a long yarn tail. These tails will be woven in later.
- 3. On some rows you'll be using more than one color this is known as tapestry weaving.
- 4. The manual includes most of the information you need to complete your Wall Hanging and be sure to visit Lionbrand.com for step by step videos of other DIY WeaverTM techniques.

Loom Configuration

Insert 28 standard pegs along the bottom row of the loom base, and 28 standard pegs along the top row of the loom base – 56 pegs total.

WALL HANGING

Watch the Tapestry and Rya videos before beginning the Wall Hanging.

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warp the Loom, set up warp across 56 pegs with G.

Weft

Row 1: Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, and working from right to left, weave one row with A.

Row 2: Working from left to right, weave one row with A.

Rows 3 and 4: Continuing to work back and forth, starting from right then from left alternately, weave 2 rows with A.

Row 5: With D, weave over and under 20 of the warp strands, then with F weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 6: With F, weave over and under the F section of Row 5, with D, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Rows 7 and 8: Weave with A only.

Rows 9 and 10: Weave same as Rows 5 and 6.

Row 11: Weave with A only.

Row 12: With F, weave over and under 26 warp strands, then with D, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 13: With D, weave over and under 20 of the warp strands, then with F weaver over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 14: With B, weave over and under 20 of the warp strands, then with C, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 15: With C, weave over and under the C part of Row 14, with B, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 16: With F, weave over and under 20 of the warp strands, then with D weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 17: With D, weave over and under the D part of Row 16, with F, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Rows 18-33: Repeat Rows 14-17 four times.

Row 34: With B, weave over and under 20 warp strands, then with C, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 35: With C, weave over and under the C section of Row 34, with B, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 36: With E, weave over and under 36 of the warp strands, then with F weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 37: With F, weave over and under the F section of previous row, with E, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Rows 38-29: Repeat Rows 36 and 37 eleven times.

Row 60: Repeat Row 36.

Row 61 Rya (Shag) Row: With F weave over and under 20 of the warp strands, with E, weave over and under 18 warp strands, with 18 remaining warp strands make 9 rya knots with F.

Row 62: With E, weave over and under 36 of the warp strands, then with F weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Row 63: With F, weave over and under the F section of Row 62, with E, weave over and under the remaining warp strands.

Rows 64 and 65: Rep Rows 62 and 63.

For Rows 66-87, follow manual instructions for Basic Weaving.

Rows 66 and 67: With D, weave 2 rows.

Rows 68 and 69: With E, weave 2 rows.

Rows 70-73: With F, weave 4 rows.

Rows 74-77: With C, weave 4 rows.

Rows 78-79: With A, weave 2 rows.

Rows 80-83: With C, weave 4 rows.

Rows 84-87: With F, weave 4 rows.

Row 88 Rya (Shag) Row: With F, weave over and under 38 warp strands, make 3 rya knots with F over next 6 warp strands, make 3 rya knots with D over next 6 warp strands, make 3 rya knots with F over last 6 warp strands.

Rows 89 and 90: With D, weave 2 rows.

Rows 91 and 92: With E, weave 2 rows.

Rep Rows 89-92 two more times.

Weave remainder of warp with B.

FINISHING

Remove Weaving From Loom

Following manual instructions for Finishing, remove the weaving from the loom.

Attach Dowel

Thread the tapestry needle with yarn in color as desired. Knot end of yarn to top right corner of Hanging. Wrap yarn over dowel, then draw through top edge of Hanging. Working from right to left, continue to wrap yarn over dowel, then draw through top edge of Hanging, until Hanging is completely attached to dowel.

Knot yarn, trim ends.

Fringes

Cut 48 strands of F approximately 12 in. (30.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 2 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use the needle weaver to draw fold through edge of piece, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 24 fringes along each short side with 2 strands of yarn in each fringe. Trim fringe evenly.

Hanger

Cut a 30 in. (76 cm) length of G. Tie ends of strand to ends of dowel.

Weave in ends.
