MATERIALS

135-223 <u>Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn:</u>
 <u>San Antonio Spur</u>

 7 Balls

<u>Lion Brand Size 13 [9 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles</u>

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)</u>

*Hometown USA (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists:** 100% Acrylic,

Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m)

Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



GAUGE:

 $10 \frac{1}{2} \text{ sts} + 16 \text{ rows} = \text{about 4 in.} (10 \text{ cm}) \text{ over Rows 1-4 of pattern.}$

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Poncho is worked in one piece, then seamed.
- 2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.





PONCHO

Cast on 50 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): K2, *p1, k2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: P2, *k1, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 3: K2, *p4, k2; rep from * to end of row. **Row 4:** P2, *k4, p2; rep from * to end of row.


Rep Rows 1-4 until your piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 4 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew cast on edge to side edge of Poncho.

Weave in yarn ends.
