#### MATERIALS

- 860-100 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice](#)  
Yarn: White  
1 Ball (A)
- 860-113 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice](#)  
Yarn: Scarlet  
1 Ball (B)
- [Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting](#)  
Needles 16 inches Size 9
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles](#)  
(Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the rnd.
2. The letter "E" is embroidered in duplicate st with B and following a chart.

#### HAT

Cast on 80 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

#### Ribbing

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* around.

Rep Rnd 1 until ribbing measures about 2 in. (5 cm) from beg.

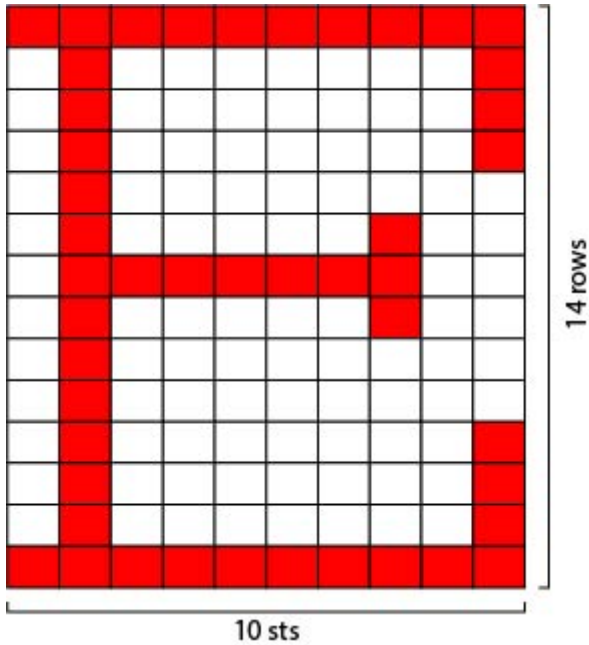
#### Body

Change to St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) and work until piece measures about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from beg. Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to close top of Hat. Knot securely.

#### FINISHING

With one strand of B threaded into blunt needle, beginning just above ribbing and following chart, duplicate st an "E" onto Hat.

Weave in ends.
