MATERIALS

- 135-219 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)
Yarn: Northfolk Merlot
2 Balls (A)
- 135-218 [Lion Brand Hometown USA](#)
Yarn: Bar Harbor Blizzard
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 \[9 mm\]](#)

Hometown USA* (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, **Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) **Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in rev St st (p on RS, k on WS).
Center cable section = about 2 in. (5 cm) wide.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.
2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked as a rectangle, then sewn together to make the Cowl.
2. Each row is divided into 3 sections. The right section is worked with A in rev St st (p on RS, k on WS) with 3 sts worked in K1, p1 Rib for border. The left section is worked with A in rev St st with 3 sts worked in Garter st (k every row) for border. The center section is worked with B in a cable pattern.
3. Work each color section of the Cowl with a separate ball of yarn. Do not carry yarn across WS of work between color changes. When changing color, twist yarns on WS to prevent holes.



COWL

With A, cast on 9 sts; with B, cast on 8 sts; with a second ball of A, cast on 9 sts – you will have 26 sts on the needle.

Row 1 (WS): With A, k9; with B, p8; with A, k6, p1, k1, p1.

Row 2 (Cable Row – RS): With A, k1, p1, k1, p6; with B, 2/2 RC, 2/2 LC; with A, p6, k3.

Row 3: With A, k9; with B, p8; with A, k6, p1, k1, p1.

Row 4: With A, k1, p1, k1, p6; with B, k8; with A, p6, k3.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rep Rows 1-6 until piece measures about 26 in. (66 cm) from beg, end with a Row 1 as the last row you work.
Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew short ends of Cowl together.

Weave in yarn ends.
