MATERIALS

- 792-437 Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Dove
3 Balls (A)
- 792-211 Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Granite Stripes
6 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Super Circs - Circular Knitting Needles Size 50 (25 mm) 45" (114 cm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Homespun Thick & Quick (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

3 1/2 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2 of Afghan with 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B (3 strands total) held together.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Afghan is worked in one piece with 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B (3 strands total) held together in Stockinette st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every row) borders.
2. As you knit, be sure to always work the sts through all 3 strands.
3. Afghan is worked on a circular needle to accommodate the large size sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.
4. For our sample Afghan, we made sure that both strands of B began at the same point in the color sequence.

AFGHAN

With 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B held together, cast on 40 sts.

Lower Border

Knit 8 rows for Garter st border.

Row 1 (WS): K4 (for Garter st side border), p to last 4 sts (for St st center of Afghan), k4 for side border.

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 54 in. (137 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 1 as the last row you work.

Top Border

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
