SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: 12 mos, 24 months (2 yrs)

Cardigan

Finished Chest About 22 (24) in. (56 (61) cm)

Finished Length About 12 (14) in. (30.5 (35.5) cm)

Hat

Finished Circumference About 16 in. (40.5 cm)

Pants

Finished Waist About 21 (23) in. (53.5 (58.5) cm), before adding elastic

Finished Length About 17 in. (43 cm), before folding for waistband and cuffs, and about 14 1/2 in. (37 cm), after folding for waistband and cuffs.

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 922-207 [Lion Brand Ice Cream Big](#)

Scoop: Strawberry

1 1 Ball

**Ice Cream Big Scoop (Article #922). 100% Acrylic; package size: 10.00oz/284.00 gr. (1117yds/1022m) pull skeins*

- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 \(4 mm\)](#)

- Additional Materials

About 20 (22) in. (51 (56) cm) elastic,

3/4 in. (19 mm) wide

3 buttons, 3/8 in. (10 mm) diameter



GAUGE:

15 hdc + 10 1/2 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Cardigan is worked in 9 pieces: Back, 2 Fronts, 2 Sleeves, 2 Pockets and 2 Flowers. Back is worked sideways beg at one side edge and working across to opposite side edge. Fronts are worked sideways beg at side edge and working across to center front edge. Sleeves are worked from lower edge upwards.
2. Pants are worked in 2 halves. Each half is worked sideways and creates one leg and half of the top of Pants. Flowers on legs are worked separately.
3. Hat is made in one piece. Hat is trimmed with 2 Flowers.

CARDIGAN


BACK

Ch 46 (54).

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 45 (53) hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-29 (31): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.



LEFT FRONT

Ch 46 (54).

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 45 (53) hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-9: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Neck

Row 10 (WS): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 8 (10) sts, sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 38 (44) sts.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch – 36 (42) sts (not counting the sl st).

Row 12: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts (not counting the sl st), sk next st, hdc in sc – 35 (41) sts.

Rows 13-15 (17): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Ch 46 (54).

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 45 (53) hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-9: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Neck

Row 10 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 7 (9) sts, sc in next st, hdc in each st to end of row working last st in top of beg ch – 38 (44) sts (not counting the sl sts).


Row 11: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 3 sts (not counting sl sts), sk next st, hdc in next st; leave last sc unworked – 36 (42) sts.

Row 12: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last st in top of beg ch.

Row 13: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, sk next st, hdc in top of beg ch – 35 (41) sts.

Rows 14-15 (17): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.



SLEEVES (make 2)

Ch 28.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 27 hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-4: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 5 (Increase Row): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in first st (increase made), hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in top of beg ch – 29 hdc.

Row 6: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last st in top of beg ch.

Rows 7-18 (20): Rep Rows 5 and 6 for 6 (7) more times – 41 (43) hdc when all

increases are completed.

Last 2 Rows: Rep Row 6 twice.

Fasten off.

POCKETS (make 2)

Ch 15.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 14 hdc at the end of this row.

Rows 2-8: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row working last sc in top of beg ch.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each st to end of row.

Fasten off.

FLOWERS (make 2)

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.

When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, 15 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), beg in next st, dc2tog, ch 3, sl st in next st, (ch 3, dc2tog, ch 3, sl st in next st) 4 times working last sl st in same st as joining.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Front and Neck Edging

Place 3 markers along Right Front edge, placing first in first st following corner at beg of neck shaping, sk next 7 sts and place 2nd marker in next st, sk next 7 sts and place 3rd marker in next st.

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in a lower corner of one of the Fronts so that you are ready to work up the front edge.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced along the front edge, around neck edge and along other front edge, working 2 sc in each corner at beg of neck shaping and working buttonholes when reaching stitch markers as follows: *work to marked st, ch 2, sk marked st and following st; rep from * 2 more times to make a total of 3 button holes.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each st and ch to end of row.

Fasten off.

Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Sew 3 buttons to Left Front edge opposite buttonholes.

Sew a Flower to each Pocket.

Sew Pockets to Fronts, centering Pockets on Fronts and matching lower edge of Pockets with lower edge of Fronts.

Weave in ends.

HAT

Ch 28.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 27 hdc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 16 in. (40.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew short edges tog for back seam. Thread rem tail in and out through top edge. Pull tail to close opening at top of Hat and knot.

FLOWERS (make 2)

Make same as Flowers for Cardigan.


FINISHING

Sew Flowers to top and side of Hat as desired.

Weave in ends.

PANTS

HALVES (make 2)



Ch 4.

Increase Section

Note: Halves are worked sideways. Increases at beg of RS rows shape top of piece. Increases at beg of WS rows shape leg end of piece.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), 2 hdc in last ch – 4 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, 2 hdc in 3rd ch of ch-3 just made (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, dc in top of beg ch – 8 sts.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in first st (increase made), hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (dc, tr) in top of beg ch – 11 sts.

Row 4: Ch 6, turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), hdc in each rem ch, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, dc in top of beg ch – 17 sts.

Row 5: Ch 27, turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), hdc in each rem ch, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (dc, tr) in top of beg ch – 45 sts.

Row 6: Ch 8, turn, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), hdc in each rem ch, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch – 52 sts.

Row 7: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, (dc, tr) in top of beg ch – 54 sts.

Row 8: Ch 11, turn hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc), hdc in each rem ch, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch – 64 sts.

Straight Section

Rows 1-22 (24): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to end of row working last st in top of beg ch.

Decrease Section

Note: Decreases at beg of RS rows shape top of piece.

Decreases at beg of WS rows shape leg end of piece.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 11 sts, sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 54 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in each st to end of row working last hdc in top of beg ch – 52 sts (not counting the sl st).

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st to last 8 sts, sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 45 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, sc in next st, hdc in each st to last 27 sts, sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 17 sts (not counting the sl st).

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next st, hdc in each st to last 6 sts, sc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 11 sts.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sl st in next st, sc in next sc, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, sc in next st, dc in next st; leave rem st unworked – 8 sts (not counting the sl st).

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, (hdc2tog) twice, dc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 4 sts.

Fasten off.

FLOWERS (make 2)

Make same as Flowers for Cardigan.


FINISHING

Sew inseams of legs, then sew remaining side edges of each half for center front and back seams. Sew a Flower to each leg, about 2 in. (5 cm) above lower edge of leg.

Waistband

Fold about 1 1/2 in. (3 cm) along top edge of Pants to RS. Sew edge to Pants for casing, leaving an opening for elastic. Thread elastic through casing. Adjust length of elastic to fit, then sew ends together. Finish sewing casing closed.

Weave in ends.
