**MATERIALS**

- 231-152 [Lion Brand Gold Leaf: Black/Silver](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 231-149 [Lion Brand Gold Leaf: Grey/Silver](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 \(9 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

*\*Gold Leaf (Article #231). 90% Acrylic, 10% Wool, Exclusive of Decoration; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr. (49yds/45m) pull skeins*



**GAUGE:**

8 1/2 sc + 5 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

**NOTES:**

1. Hat is worked in one piece in continuous rnds (spiral) beg at top.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not fasten off old color. Carry color not in use up inside of Hat until next needed.

**HAT**

Make an adjustable ring as follows: Wrap A around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring. When Rnd 1 is complete, gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 1, work 3 sc in ring; with B, work 3 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – you will have 6 sc at the end of this rnd. Place marker for beg of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** With B, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts; with A, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts – 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** With A, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times; with B, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** With B, (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times; with A, (sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** With A, (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times; with B, (sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times – 30 sc.

**Rnd 6:** With B, (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times; with A, (sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times – 36 sc.

**Rnd 7:** With A, (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times; with B, (sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) 3 times – 42 sc.

**Rnd 8:** With B, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 10 times; with A, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 10 times,

ch 1, sk next st – 21 sc and 21 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 9:** With A, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp) 10 times; with B, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp) 10 times, ch 1.

**Rnd 10:** With B, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp) 10 times; with A, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp) 10 times, ch 1.

**Rnds 11-18:** Rep Rnds 9 and 10 four more times.

**Rnd 19:** With A, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp) 10 times; leave remaining sts unworked.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
