MATERIALS

• 790-439 Lion Brand Homespun: Tourmaline 1 Ball

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook -Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

3 pattern reps = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm). Note: Each (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) group counts as 1 pattern rep.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Puff St (worked all in one st) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), *yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop; rep from * once more, yarn over, draw through all 7 loops on hook.

NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked in one piece in joined and turned rnds in a Puff st pattern.

2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 60, (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) in 4th ch from hook (skipped 3 ch do not count as a st), *sk next 2 ch, (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk last 2 ch; join with sl st in top of beg ch - you will have 38 Puff st and 19 ch-1 sps at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

3. A Puff st is easy to do, but it's important to remember to make generous sized loops. The pattern stitch can become wider and stretchier as it goes along, so we found it most attractive to use the foundation ch as the top edge of the Cowl.

Loosely ch 57; join with sl st in first ch to make a ring, taking care not to twist ch. **Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) in same ch as joining, *sk next 2 ch, (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk last 2 ch; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 38 Puff sts and 19 ch-1 sps. **Rnds 2-12:** Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, (Puff st, ch 1, Puff st) in each ch-1 sp to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
