88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size:  
8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins*

### MATERIALS

- 792-238 [Lion Brand Homespun Thick & Quick Yarn: Midnight Stripes](#)  
1 Ball (A)
- 790-404 [Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Lagoon](#)  
2 Balls (B)
- [Lion Brand Super Circs - Circular Knitting Needles Size 50 \(25 mm\) 45" \(114 cm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

### GAUGE:

4 sts + 5 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St St worked in rnds (k every rnd) with 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B held together.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked in one piece in the round on a circular needle with 3 strands of yarn held together.
2. When working with multiple strands of yarn, hold all strands together and work just as if using one strand.
3. To help keep yarns from tangling, you may find it helpful to put each skein into a separate zip lock bag. Zip each bag nearly closed, leaving an opening just large enough for the yarn strand to emerge.

### COWL

With 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B held together (3 strands total), cast on 68 sts.

Place marker for beginning of rnd.

Join for working in the rnd by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand

needle, being careful not to twist.  
P 1 rnd, k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd.  
Work in St st (k every rnd) for 10 rnds.  
P 1 rnd, k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd.  
Bind off loosely.

## FINISHING

Thread the yarn tails, one at a time, into blunt needle and weave in ends.
