MATERIALS

- 135-103 Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Baton Rouge Fuchsia
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
3 jumbo sew-on snap fasteners
Sewing needle and thread

Hometown USA (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic, **Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) **Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

11 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Broken Rib pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Broken Rib Pattern (worked over an odd number of sts)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *p1, k1; rep from * across.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Broken Rib pattern.

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in Broken Rib pattern, with beginning and ending Garter st (knit every row) borders.
2. Stitches are bound off to make a slit in Scarf.
3. Jumbo snaps are sewed to Scarf. The slit and the snaps create multiple wearing options.

SCARF

Cast on 21 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) for 10 rows.

Next Row: Purl.

Beginning with Row 1, work in Broken Rib pattern until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 2 of Broken Rib as the last row you work.

Shape slit

Next Row: Work Row 1 of Broken Rib pattern across 6 sts, bind off next 9 sts, over last 5 sts, k1, (p1, k1) twice.

Next Row: P6, cast on 9 sts, p to end of row.

Beginning with Row 1, work in Broken Rib pattern until piece measures about 35 in. (89 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 2 of Broken Rib as the last row you work.

Work in Garter st for 10 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

With sewing needle and thread, sew 3 snaps evenly spaced along each Garter st end of Scarf.
