SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 16 in. (40.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height About 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 635-187 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Buttercup
1 Ball
- Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 16 inches Size 10
- Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 10
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Wool-Ease Tonal (Article #635). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 4.00oz/113.00 gr. (124yds/113m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Mistake st rib.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Mistake Stitch Rib (worked over a multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * around.

Rnd 2: K1, *p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Rep Rnds 1 and 2 for Mistake st Rib.

NOTES:

Hat is worked in one piece in the rnd, beginning on a circular needle then changing to double-pointed needles.

HAT

With circular needle, cast on 60 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd and join by knitting the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist.

Begin with Rnd 1, work in Mistake st rib until piece measures about 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) from beg, end with a Rnd 2 as the

last row you work.

Change to double-pointed needles as you work the next rnd.

Next Rnd: *K2tog, p2tog; rep from* around – you will have 30 sts at the end of this rnd.

Next Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then through sts of last rnd. Pull to gather top of Hat and knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
