SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference at Lower Edge About 49 1/2 in. (125.5 cm)

Finished Circumference at Upper Edge About 36 in. (91.5 cm)

Finished Height About 24 in. (61 cm)

MATERIALS

- 595-214 Lion Brand Color Waves:

Newsprint

2 Balls (A)

- 595-206 Lion Brand Color Waves:

Marble

2 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Size 13 [9 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Color Waves (Article #595). 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (306yds/280m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rnds 8-14 with 2 strands held together.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Cowl is worked in one piece in the round with 2 strands of yarn (one strand of each color) held together.



COWL

With one strand of each color yarn held together, loosely cast on 111 sts.

Place marker for beginning of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist.

Place 2 additional markers as follows: One marker between sts 37 and 38 and the other between sts 74 and 75.

Rnds 1, 3 & 5: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 2, 4 & 6: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 7 (Decrease Rnd): *Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, slip marker; rep from * twice more - 3 sts decreased.

Rnds 8-14: Knit.

Rnd 15: Rep Rnd 7.

Rep Rnds 1-15 four more times.

When all reps have been worked, you will have 81 sts remaining.

Rep Rnds 1-5 once more, then bind off all sts loosely and in pattern (Row 6).

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
