GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

- 1. The Clutch is woven in one piece with shaping for the front flap. Piece is then folded and seamed along the sides.
- 2. The warp is set up in stripes alternating A and B yarns, the weft is also woven in stripes to create a plaid pattern.

Loom Set-Up

Following DIY Weaver ExtenderTM kit manual instructions, connect loom base from starter kit to loom base from extender kit.

Following diagram, insert standards pegs along bottom and top edges of loom bases – 56 pegs placed for warp.

CLUTCH

Warp


Following manual instructions for Warping and diagram for stripe pattern, set up the warp across 56 pegs as follows:

8 pegs with A, 6 pegs with B, 8 pegs with A, 12 pegs with B, 8 pegs with A, 6 pegs with B, 8 pegs with A.

Weft

Following the weaver manual instructions for Basic Weaving, weave the weft changing color as follows:





Button Loop

Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) length of A, fold length in half. Make a knot about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from fold. With sewing needle and thread sew ends of loop to center of inside edge of flap.

Sew button to front of Clutch opposite the loop.
