



Lion Brand® Vanna's Style Allworth Angled Scarf

EASY

SIZE

About 6 1/2 x 52 in. (16.5 x 132 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® VANNA'S STYLE (Art. #867)
#142 Claret 1 ball
or color of your choice
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 in. (5 cm) piece of heavy cardboard for making tassels

GAUGE

16 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 27 and 28 of pattern.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

dc-blo (double crochet in back loop only) Yarn over, insert hook in back loop only of indicated st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice.

dc2tog (double crochet 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Scarf is worked in one piece.
2. Increases and decreases are worked to shape the angled ends of the Scarf.

SCARF

First Angled End

Ch 2.

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first sc, dc in last sc – at the end of this row you will have 3 dc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, 2 sc in top of beg ch – 4 sc.

Row 4: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, sc in first st, dc-blo in last 3 sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, dc-blo in next st, 2 dc in top of beg ch – 6 sts.

Row 6: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, sc in first 3 sts, dc-blo in last 3 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts, 2 sc in top of beg ch – 8 sts.

Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc-blo in next st, sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in last 3 sts – 9 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in top of beg ch – 10 sts.

Row 10: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, sc in first st, dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in last 3 sts.

Row 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next st, 2 dc in top of beg ch – 12 sts.

Row 12: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, beg in first st, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to end of row.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn, beg in first st, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to beg ch, 2 sc in top of beg ch – 14 sts.

Row 14: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc-blo in next st, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to end of row – 15 sts.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, beg in first st, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in top of beg ch – 16 sts.

Row 16: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, sc in first st, dc-blo in next 3 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to end of row.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, *dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to 1 st before beg ch, dc-blo in next st, 2 dc in top of beg ch – 18 sts.

Rows 18-23: Rep Rows 12-17 – 24 sts.

Rows 24-26: Rep Rows 12-14 – 27 sts.

Body of Scarf

Row 27: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, *dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to end of row.

Row 28: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to end of row.

Rows 29-106: Rep Rows 27 and 28 for 39 more times.

Second Angled End

Row 107: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 2 sts, *dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * across working last sc in top of beg ch – 26 sts.

Row 108: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 5 sts, sc in next 3 sts, dc2tog – 25 sts.

Row 109: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first st, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 24 sts.

Row 110: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, sc in next st, sk next st, sc in top of beg ch – 23 sts.

Row 111: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first st, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next st, *sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 22 sts.

Row 112: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, *dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 4 sts, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch – 21 sts.

Rows 113-118: Rep Rows 107-112 – 15 sts at the end of Row 118.

Rows 119-123: Rep Rows 107-111 – 10 sts at the end of Row 123.

Row 124: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch – 9 sts.

Row 125: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next 2 sts, dc-blo in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 8 sts.

Row 126: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, dc2tog – 7 sts.

Row 127: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first st, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 6 sts.

Row 128: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc-blo in next 2 sts, sc in next st, sk next st, sc in top of beg ch – 5 sts.

Row 129: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first st, ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next st, sc in next 2 sts, sc in top of beg ch – 4 sts.

Row 130: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch – 3 sts.

Row 131: Ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next st, sc in top of beg ch – 2 sts.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Tassels (make 2)

Wrap yarn around 2 in. (5 cm) cardboard, the more wraps the fuller the tassel. Cut a 20 in. (51 cm) length of yarn and thread into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot. Insert crochet hook under tied strand, yarn over with yarn tails and draw up a loop (chain made), continue to work chains with doubled strand of yarn for about 2 in. (5 cm), then join with a sl st to one angled end of Scarf.

Fasten off.

Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) length of yarn and wrap tightly around loops about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) below top to make tassel neck.

Knot, then thread ends into blunt needle and weave to center of tassel.

Trim Tassel ends evenly.

Repeat to make a tassel on opposite end of Scarf.

Weave in yarn ends.
