

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton Lovie's Blanket

Pattern Number: L60170



SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE:

About 30 x 30 in. (76 x 76 cm)

MATERIALS:

Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton (Art. #761)

- #144 Magenta 1 ball (A)
- #142 Rose 1 ball (B)
- #098 Ecru 1 ball (C)
- #156 Mint 1 ball (D)
- #178 Jade 1 ball (E)
- #147 Purple 1 ball (F)
- or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE:

Four pattern reps = about 4 in. (10 cm). Note: One pattern rep consists of one 3-dc group and the following ch-1 sp.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES:

- 1. Blanket is worked in joined rnds with RS always facing.
- 2. After Rnd 4, the yarn color is changed every other rnd.
- 3. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and draw up a loop of new color in any corner ch-3 sp.

BLANKET INSTRUCTIONS:

With A, ch 6, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), work 3 dc in ring, (ch 3, 3 dc in ring) twice, ch 3, 2 dc in ring; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – you will have 12 dc (four 3-dc groups) and 4 ch-3 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: Sl st in first ch-sp, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), 3 dc in same ch-3 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, work 2 more dc in first ch-3 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 24 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-3 sps).

Rnd 3: Sl st in first ch-sp, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), 3 dc in same ch-3 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, work 2 more dc in first ch-3 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 36 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-3 sps).

Rnd 4: Sl st in first ch-sp, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), 3 dc in same ch-3 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, work 2 more dc in first ch-3 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 48 dc, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (four 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-3 sps).

Fasten off.

Rnd 5 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop of B in any corner ch-3 sp, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), 3 dc in same ch-3 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to first ch-3 sp, ch 1, work 2 more dc in first ch-3 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 60 dc, 16 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (five 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-3 sps).

Rnd 6: Sl st in first ch-sp, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), 3 dc in same ch-3 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to first ch-3 sp, ch 1, work 2 more dc in first ch-3 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 72 dc, 20 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (six 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-3 sps). Fasten off.

Rnds 7-29: Rep Rnds 5 and 6 nine more times, changing yarn color as in following color sequence: Work next 2 rnds with C, 2 rnds with D, 2 rnds with E, 2 rnds with F, 2 rnds with A, 2 rnds with B, 2 rnds with C, 2 rnds with D, 2 rnds with E, 2 rnds with F, 2 rnds with A, and 1 rnd with B – you will have 348 dc, 112 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (twenty-nine 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides in Rnd 29).

Rnd 30: Ch 1, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp around, working 3 sc in each corner ch-3 sp; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS:

Weave in yarn ends.

ch = chain
ch-sp(s) = space(s) previously made
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
