GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

NOTES

1. You should have some experience weaving with the DIY Weaver™ before making the Owl Mat.
2. Be sure to watch the Owl Mat video, as well as other weaving techniques at Lionbrand.com.
3. Pegs are placed according a placement diagram.
4. Mat is worked from the Owl chart. We suggest printing 2 copies of the chart – one to lay onto the loom base between the pegs, and the other copy is kept nearby to refer to as you weave.

OWL

Peg Configuration

Following the diagram, insert 23 standard pegs into the bottom row of the loom base and 29 standard pegs into top of the loom base – 52 pegs total.

Warp

Note: Pegs are warped in 3 sections to make the Mat: left wing and right wing are warped first, then beginning from left ear tuft, the body is warped.

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up warp across 52 pegs as follows:

1. With A, warp the 7 pegs of the outer edge of left wing.
2. Repeat Step 1 for 7 pegs of right wing.
3. Warp the remaining 38 pegs from right ear tuft across the body to the left ear tuft.

Weft

Notes:

1. Weft is worked by following the Owl chart and manual instructions for Basic Weaving. Head and Eyes section is worked in Tapestry Weaving. Go to Lionbrand.com for a detail Tapestry Weaving video.
2. Always cut the old yarn color before starting to weave the new color.
3. For smaller sections of color, you may want to change from the shuttle to the needle weaver or tapestry needle.
4. Colors B, C, and D are woven with one strand of yarn, color E is woven with two strands of yarn held together.
5. First left wing is worked, then right wing, then center belly. As you weave, you'll notice slits will form between the sections – you'll sew these when weaving is complete. These sections are worked from the top down.

Following the Owl Chart and the video instructions for The Owl Mat, weave the weft, beginning with the left wing, working from the top down with D.

Following the Owl Chart, weave the weft for the right wing, working from the top down with D.

Following the Owl Chart, weave the center belly, working from the top down with C.

Begin Tapestry Weaving

Continuing to follow the Owl Chart, weave head with one strand of B, and eyes with two stands of E.

Finish weaving head with B, working left ear tuft and right ear tuft separately with the needle weaver.

FINISHING

Remove Weaving From Loom

Following manual instructions for finishing, remove the weaving from the loom.

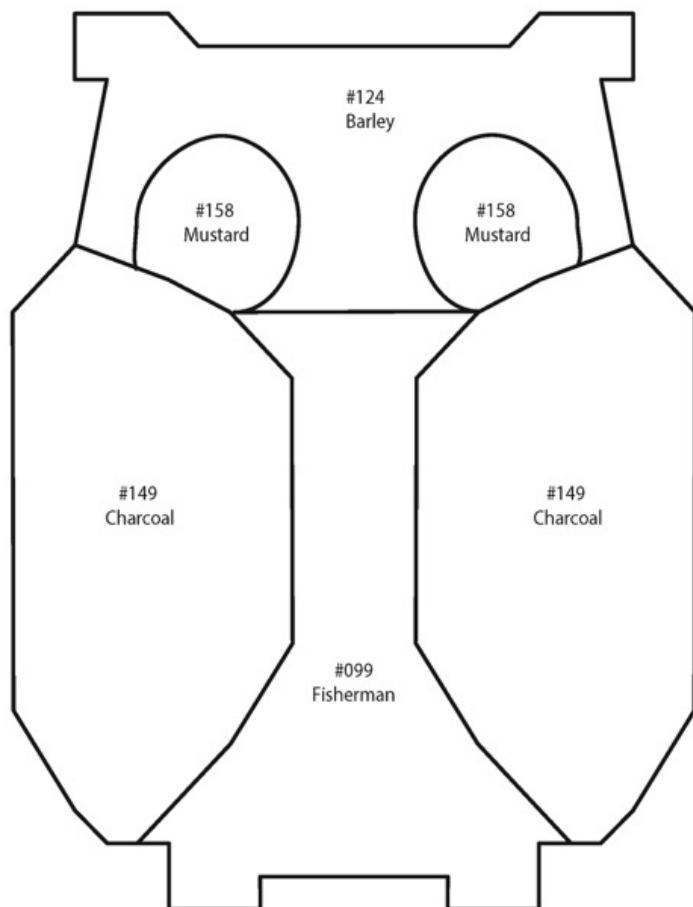
Embroidery

With 2 strands of E and tapestry needle, embroider claws, and beak onto Owl.

With 2 strands of F and tapestry needle, embroider pupils on eyes of Owl.

Sew slits from wings and belly.

Weave in yarn ends.

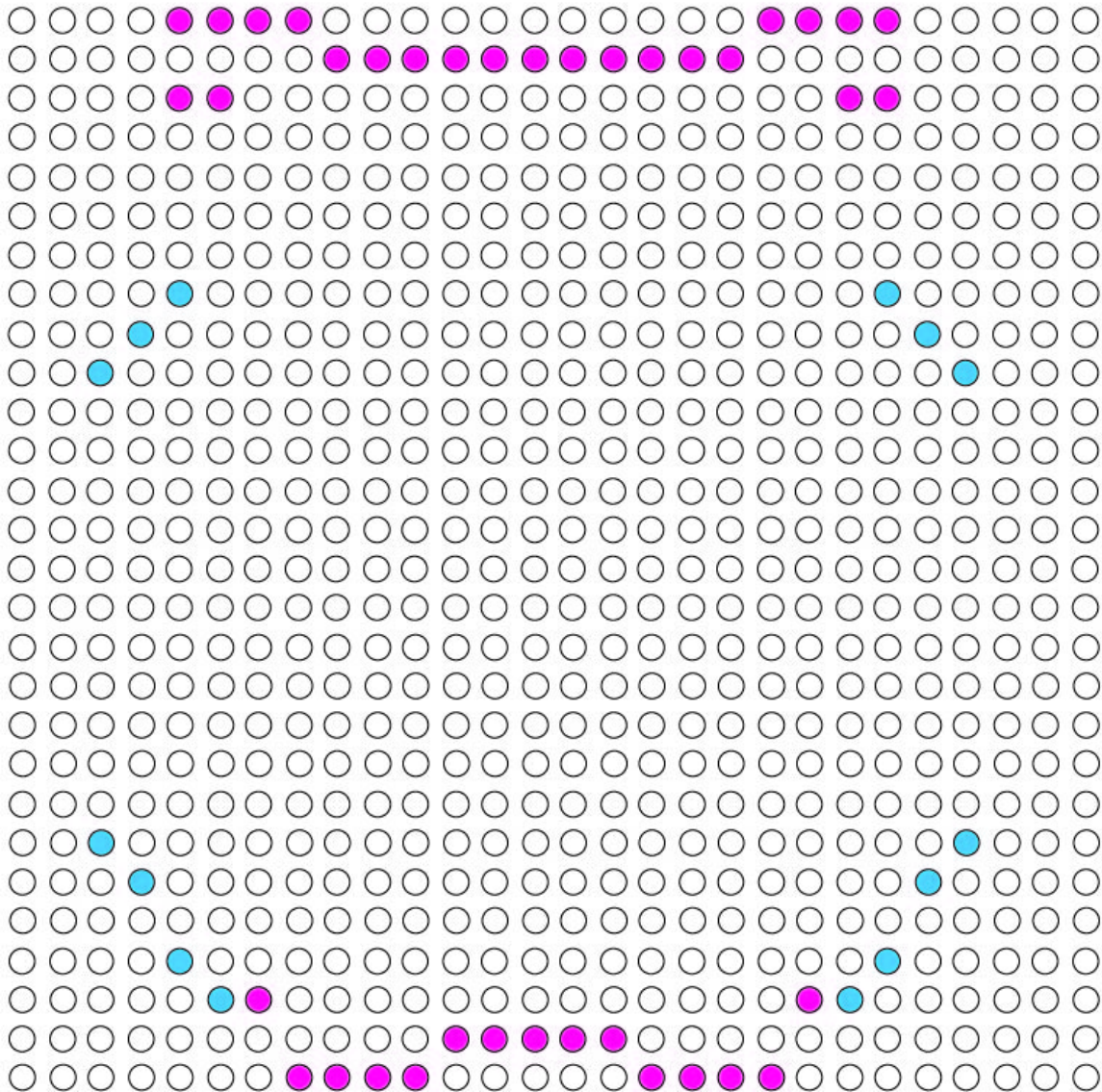


Left Ear Tuft
