

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand® Heartland® Bette Bolero with Scarf

Pattern Number: L40754



SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

SIZES

S (M/L, 1X/2X)

Finished Bust 36 (44, 52) in. (91.5 (112, 132) cm)

Finished Length 15 1/2 (17, 18 1/2) in. (39.5 (43, 47) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® (Art. #136)
 - 149 Great Smoky Mountains 3

 (3, 4) balls (A)867-147 Purple 1
 ball (B)
 - 147 Hot Springs 1 (1, 2) ball(s)
 (B)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

13 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 2 and 3 of Back. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st or sp and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Back and 2 Fronts of Bolero are worked separately.
- 2. The Fronts are identical. The pattern stitch is reversible, simply flip one Front over so that it is the mirror image of the other Front.
- Sleeves are worked from shoulders down after shoulders are seamed.
- 4. Scarf is worked separately, then sewn to Back neck.

5. An edging is worked around completed Bolero and Scarf.

BACK

With A, ch 60 (72, 84).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 59 (71, 83) sc at the end of Row 1.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first hdc and ch 1), turn, sk next st, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * to end of row – 30 (36, 42) hdc and 29 (35, 41) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, *hdc in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next hdc; rep from * to end of row – 59 (71, 83) hdc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Back measures about 13 1/2 (15, 16 1/2) in. (34.5 (38, 42) cm) from beg, ending with a Row 3 (RS row) as the last row you work. Fasten off.

FRONTS (make 2)

With A, ch 32 (38, 44).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 31 (37, 43) sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first hdc and ch 1), turn, sk next st, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * to end of row – 16 (19, 22) hdc and 15 (18, 21) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, *hdc in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next hdc; rep from * to end of row – 31 (37, 43) hdc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Front measures about 8 1/2 (10, 11 1/2) in. (21.5 (25.5, 29) cm) from beg, ending with a Row 3 (RS row) as the last row you work.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (Dec Row - WS): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, hdc2tog over next 2 sts, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * to end of row – 16 (19, 22) hdc and 14 (17, 20) ch-1 sps.

Row 2 (Dec Row - RS): Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, *hdc in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next hdc; rep from * to last ch-1 sp, hdc2tog over next sp and next st, hdc in last st – 29 (35, 41) hdc.

Rep the last 2 rows 5 more times – 19 (25, 31) hdc. Fasten off.

Sleeves

Sew Fronts to Back at shoulders.

Place markers 7 1/2 (8 1/2, 9 1/2) in. (19 (21.5, 24) cm below shoulder seams on Fronts and Back for Sleeves. From RS, join A with a sl st at marker so you are ready to work a RS row across to other marker.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 49 (55, 61) sc evenly spaced between markers.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first hdc and ch 1), turn, sk next st, hdc in next st, *sk next st, ch 1, hdc in next st; rep from * to end of row – 25 (28, 31) hdc and 24 (27, 30) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, *hdc in next ch-1 sp, hdc in next hdc; rep from * to end of row – 49 (55, 61) hdc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until Sleeve measures about 11 (10, 9) in. (28 (25.5, 23) cm), ending with a Row 3 (RS row) as the last row you work. Fasten off.

Next Row (RS): From RS, join B with a sl st at beg of last row, ch 1, sc in each st to end of row -49 (55, 61) sc.

Next 3 Rows: Ch 2 (does not count as as a st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st to end of row.

Fasten off. Change to A.

Edging Row: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row

Fasten off.

Make second Sleeve the same way.

SCARF

With B, ch 134.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 133 sc.

Rows 2-13: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st to end of row – 133 hdc.

Row 14: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc in first 55 sts and place a marker in last st made, hdc in next 24 sts and place a marker in last st made, hdc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Sew marked portion of last row of Scarf to Back neck.

Lower Border

From RS, join B with a sl st at lower right Front corner so you are ready to work a RS row across lower edge of Bolero.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced across lower edge of Bolero.

Rows 2-4: Ch 2 (does not count as as a st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st to end of row.

Fasten off.

Edging

From RS, join A with a sl st at either side of Back neck.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around entire outside edge of joined Bolero and Scarf; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
