DRESS

Finished Chest About 25 in. (63.5 cm) **Finished Length** About 21 in. (53.5 cm)

<u>HAT</u>

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Style (Art. #867)
 - 098 Ecru 2 balls (A)
 - 178 Teal 1 ball (B)
 - 110 Navy 1 ball (C)
 - 159 Mustard 1 ball (D)
 - 113 Red 1 ball (E)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

1 Granny Square = about 3 x 3 in. (7.5 x 7.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

corner-dec (corner decrease – worked over corner ch-2 sps of 3 Squares at inner corner) Draw up a loop in next dc of current Square, draw up a loop in corner ch-2 sp of next Square (beside last Square worked into), draw up a loop in next dc of next Square (above last Square worked into), yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook. See diagram.

hdc2tog-over-2-sps (half double crochet worked over 2 chain-spaces) Yarn over, insert hook in next ch-sp and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), sk next st, yarn over, insert hook in next ch-sp and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 2, dc) in indicated st or sp.



NOTES

- 1. 37 Granny Squares are worked first 25 for Dress and 12 for Hat.
- Each Granny Square is worked in 3 joined rnds with RS always facing.
 Each rnd is worked with a different yarn color. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a diagram.
- 3. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and join new color as instructed.
- 4. Squares are crocheted together following diagrams, then remainder of Dress and Hat is worked.

GRANNY SQUARES (make 37)

Notes: To make both Dress and Hat, make Granny Squares in the following quantities and color sequences. To make Dress only make only 25 Granny Squares of your choice. To make Hat only make only 12 Granny Squares of your choice.

Granny Square I (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with C. Granny Square II (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with E. Granny Square III (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with C, Rnd 3 with E. Granny Square IV (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with E. Granny Square V (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with D. Granny Square VI (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with A, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square VIII (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with D. Granny Square IX (make 1): Work Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square X (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with D. Granny Square XI (make 1): Work Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with C. Granny Square XII (make 1): Work Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square XIII (make 3): Work Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with E, Rnd 3 with D. Granny Square XIII (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with E, Rnd 2 with A, Rnd 3 with D. Granny Square XIV (make 4): Work Rnd 1 with E, Rnd 2 with C, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square XIV (make 4): Work Rnd 1 with E, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square XV (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with E, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B. Granny Square XV (make 2): Work Rnd 1 with E, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B.

With smaller hook and first color, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. **Rnd 1 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-2 sps in this rnd.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS with smaller hook, draw up a loop of 2nd color in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp for corner, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp for corner; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch — Eight 3-dc groups, 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 4 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS with smaller hook, draw up a loop of 3rd color in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same corner ch-2 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twelve 3-dc groups, 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 8 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

DRESS

Arrange squares in colors as desired, following diagram.

Joining Squares

From RS with smaller hook, working in both Squares on each side of a vertical seam line, join A with a sl st in corner ch-2 sp at beg of line, *ch 1, sl st in next st, (ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, sl st in next st) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in corner ch-2 sp of next Square; rep from * all the way along the vertical line ending last rep at **. Fasten off.

Rep until all vertical lines of Squares have been joined. Rep along all horizontal lines of Squares.

Front and Neck Edging

Row 1 (RS): From RS with smaller hook, join A with sc in corner ch-2 sp of Square at lower right front corner, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, sc in next st or seam between Squares) to ch-2 sp at next outer corner, ch 1, sc in corner ch-2 sp and place a marker in the sc just made; beg along next edge of same Square, *ch 1, (sc in next st or seam, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1) to 1 st before next inner corner, corner-dec, sk next st; rep from * 3 more times, ch 1, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, sc in next st) to next outer corner, ch 1, sc in corner ch-2 sp and place a marker in the sc just made, ch 1, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, sc in next st or seam) to corner ch-2 sp at lower left front corner, sc in corner ch-2 sp.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, *hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * to ch-1 sp before next marker, [(hdc, ch 1, hdc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] twice and move marker to center ch-1 sp at corner, [**hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from ** to ch-1 sp before next corner-dec, hdc2tog-over-2-sps, ch 1] 4 times, ***hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from *** to ch-1 sp before next marker, [(hdc, ch 1, hdc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] twice and move marker to center ch-1 sp at corner, ****hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from **** to last 2 sts, sk next st, hdc in last st. Fasten off.

Row 3: From RS, draw up a loop of B in first st at lower right front corner, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to ch-1 sp just made, [**ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to 2 ch-1 sps at next inner corner, ch 1, hdc2tog-over-2-sps] 4 times, ***ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *** to next marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to ch-1 sp just made, ****ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from **** to beg ch, ch 1, hdc in beg ch-sp, hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch.
Fasten off.

Row 4: From WS, draw up a loop of C in first st at lower left front corner, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp;

rep from * to marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to center hdc just made, [**ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to 2 ch-1 sps at next inner corner, ch 1, hdc2tog-over-2-sps] 4 times, ***ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *** to marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to center hdc just made, ****ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from **** to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next hdc, hdc in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

Row 5: From RS, draw up a loop of D in first st at lower right front corner, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to ch-1 sp before marker, [ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in next ch-1 sp] twice and move marker to center ch-1 sp at corner, [**ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to 2 ch-1 sps at next inner corner, ch 1, hdc2tog-over-2-sps] 4 times, ***ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *** to ch-1 sp before marker, [ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in next ch-1 sp] twice and move marker to center ch-1 sp at corner, ****ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from **** to beg ch, ch 1, hdc in beg ch-sp, hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch. Fasten off.

Row 6: From WS, draw up a loop of E in first st at lower left front corner, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to ch-1 sp just made, [**ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to 2 ch-1 sps at next inner corner, ch 1, hdc2tog-over-2-sps] 4 times, ***ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from *** to marked corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in corner ch-1 sp and move marker to ch-1 sp just made, ****ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from **** to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next hdc, hdc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Row 7: From RS, join A with sc in first st at lower right front corner, sc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * all the way along edges to st before beg ch in lower left front corner, ch 1, sk next st, sc in beg ch-sp, sc in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Sleeve Edging

From RS with smaller hook, join A with sc in sleeve seam, ch 1, *sc in next st or seam, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Skirt

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS with smaller hook, join A with sc in any dc of lower edge of bodice beneath one of the sleeves, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, *sc in next st or seam, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1; rep from * all the way around lower edge; join with sl st in first sc – 60 sc and 60 ch-1 sps. Note: When working in side edges of front edging work as follows: (ch 1, sc in end of next row) across side of front

edging at lower right front, then (ch 1, sc in end of next row) across side of front edging at lower left front.

Rnd 2 (RS): SI st in next ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *sk next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last ch-1 sp, sk last ch-1 sp; join with sI st in top of beg ch — Thirty 3-dc groups.

Rnd 3 (WS): SI st in next dc (center dc of first 3-dc group), turn, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same dc (first V-st made), V-st in center dc of each 3-dc group around; join with sI st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 30 V-sts.

Rnd 4 (RS): Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp of first V-st, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-sp, 3 dc in ch-2 sp of next 2 V-sts, V-st in next sp between V-sts, *3 dc in ch-2 sp of next 3 V-sts, V-st in next sp between V-sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Thirty 3-dc groups and 10 V-sts.

Rnd 5: Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp of first V-st, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same ch-sp (first V-st made), V-st in center dc of each 3-dc group and in ch-2 sp of each V-st around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5 – 40 V-sts.

Rnd 6: Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp of first V-st, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-sp, V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st, *3 dc in ch-2 sp of next V-st, V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Twenty 3-dc groups and 20 V-sts.

Rnd 7: Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in ch-2 sp of first V-st, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), dc in same ch-sp (first V-st made), 3 dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, *V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st, 3 dc in center dc of next 3-dc group; rep from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-5.

Rnd 8: Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in next dc (center dc of first 3-dc group), ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same dc, V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st, *3 dc in center dc of next 3-dc group, V-st in ch-2 sp of next V-st; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnds 9-12: Rep Rnds 7 and 8 twice.

Change to larger hook.

Rnds 13-16: With larger hook, rep Rnds 7 and 8 twice.

Rnd 17: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 18: Turn, sl st in next dc, sl st in next dc (center dc of first 3-dc group), ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), dc in same dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in ch-2 sp of each V-st and in center dc of each 3-dc group around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 40 (dc, ch 3, dc) groups.

Rnd 19; Turn, sl st in first sp between sts, ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp, *ch 3, sl st in next sp between sts, ch 3, sl st in next ch-3 sp; rep from * around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Front Tie

With smaller hook and A, work a chain about 45 in. (114.5 cm) long. Fasten off.

Weave tie in and out through ch-sps of Row 7 of front edging to close fronts.

Weave in yarn ends.

HAT

Arrange squares in colors as desired, following diagram.

Joining Squares

From RS with smaller hook, working in both Squares on each side of a vertical seam line, join A with a sl st in corner ch-2 sp at beg of line, *ch 1, sl st in next st, (ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, sl st in next st) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, sl st in corner ch-2 sp of next Square; rep from * all the way along the vertical line ending last rep at **. Fasten off.

Rep until all vertical lines of Squares have been joined. The last vertical join of first and last Squares makes a ring. Rep to join the single horizontal line of Squares.

Lower Edge

Rnd 1: From RS with smaller hook, join A with sc in any st or seam between Squares of one long edge, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, *sc in next st or seam, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc and 42 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: SI st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), *hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sI st in 2nd ch of beg ch. Fasten off.

Top of Hat

Rnd 1: From RS with smaller hook, join A with sc in any st or seam between Squares of unworked long edge, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1, *sc in next st or seam, ch 1, sk next st or ch-1; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 42 sc and 42 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), *hdc2tog-over-2-sps, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first st – 21 hdc2tog and 21 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, join B with sl st in any ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), *hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Rnds 4-6: Rep Rnd 3 three times working Rnd 4 with C, Rnd 5 with D, and Rnd 6 with E.

Fasten off.

Rnd 7: From RS, join A with sc in any ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st, *sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

Top Tie

With smaller hook and A, work a chain about 30 in. (76 cm) long. Fasten off.

Weave chain in and out through ch-sps of Rnd 4. Pull on ends of chain to gather top of Hat then tie ends into a bow.

Weave in yarn ends.
