## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

## **SIZE**

About 51 x 51 in. (129.5 x 129.5 cm) not including border

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice (Art. #860)
  - 126 Chocolate 1 ball (A)
  - 124 Toffee 1 ball (B)
  - 130 Honey 1 ball (C)
  - 153 Black 1 ball (D)
  - 404 Dark Grey Heather 1 ball (E)
  - 405 Silver Heather 1 ball (F)
  - 147 Purple 1 ball (G)
  - 146 Dusty Purple 1 ball (H)
  - 202 Purple Print 1 ball (I)
  - 406 Obsidian 1 ball (J)
  - 407 Graphite 1 ball (K)
  - 401 Grey Marble 1 ball (L)
  - 403 Barley 1 ball (M)
  - 400 Oatmeal 1 ball (N)
  - 125 Taupe 1 ball (O)
  - 123 Beige 1 ball (P)
  - 151 Charcoal Grey 1 ball (Q)
  - 149 Silver Grey 1 ball (R)
  - 402 Wheat 1 ball (S)
  - 098 Fisherman 1 ball (T)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

## **GAUGE**

16 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

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## **NOTES**

1. 25 Blocks are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram to make the Afghan.
2. Each Block begins with a center, then 4 logs are worked around 3 sides of the center.
3. When working with 2 colors, carry the yarn color not in use up the side edge of the piece until next needed.
4. A border is worked across each outside edge of the Afghan.
5. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts on the border. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

## **GENERAL BLOCK INSTRUCTIONS**

**Note:** Follow the instructions below to make each Block, changing color following the Color Chart.

### **Center**

With straight needles and 1st color, cast on 25 sts.

**Row 1:** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

**Rows 3-38:** Rep Row 2.

Bind off.

### **1st Log**

Turn center counter-clockwise.

From RS with 2nd color, pick up and k25 sts evenly spaced across side edge of Center.

Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 11 rows.

Bind off.

### **2nd Log**

From RS with 3rd color, pick up and k33 sts evenly spaced across cast-on edge of Center and side edge of 1st Log.

**Row 1 (WS):** With 3rd color, knit.

**Row 2:** With 4th color, knit.

**Row 3:** With 4th color, purl.

**Rows 4 and 5:** With 3rd color, knit.

**Rows 6-13:** Rep Rows 2-5.

Bind off.

### **3rd Log**

From RS with 5th color, pick up and k33 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 2nd Log and bound-off edge of 1st Log.

Knit 13 rows.

Bind off.

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#### 4th Log

From RS with 6th color, pick up and k41 sts evenly spaced across side edges of 3rd Log and 1st Log, and cast-on edge of Center.

Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st for 11 rows.

Bind off.

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## **FINISHING**

Following diagram, sew Blocks into 5 strips of 5 Blocks each. Sew strips together to make Afghan.

### **Border**

**First Side:** From RS with circular needle and K, pick up and k197 sts evenly spaced across one side edge of Afghan. Knit 5 rows.

Bind off.

**Second Side:** From RS with circular needle and E, pick up and k200 sts evenly spaced across side edge of first side border and next side edge of Afghan. Knit 5 rows.

Bind off.

**Third Side:** From RS with circular needle and R, pick up and k200 sts evenly spaced across side edge of second side border and next side edge of Afghan.

Knit 5 rows.

Bind off.

**Fourth side:** From RS with circular needle and Q, pick up and k203 sts evenly spaced across side edge of third side border, next side edge of Afghan, and edge of first side border. Knit 5 rows.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
