 - 110 Navy 2 (3, 3) balls (A)
 - 113 Red 1 (2, 2) ball(s) (B)
 - 102 Aqua 2 (3, 3) balls (C)
 - 172 Grass 1 (2, 3) ball(s) (D)
 - 098 Ecru 2 (3, 3) balls (É)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size E-4 (3.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

4 x 4 in. (10 x 10 cm) piece of heavy cardboard (for making tassels)

<u>GAUGE</u>

4 1/2 Pyramids + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Pyramid St pattern. 18 tr = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

dtr (double treble/triple crochet) (Yarn over) 3 times, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times. **Pyramid** Ch 6, sc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch.

PATTERN STITCHES

Pyramid Stitch Pattern (begins with a foundation ch that is a multiple of 4 ch + 2 additional ch)

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *make Pyramid, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across.

Row 2: Ch 6 (counts as dtr, ch 1), turn, sc in tip of first Pyramid, *ch 3, sc in tip of next Pyramid; rep from * to last sc, ch 1, dtr in last sc.

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Row 3: Ch 10 (counts as dtr, ch 5), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, sc in next sc, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 5, dtr in 5th ch of turning ch.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 3, sc in tip of next Pyramid; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 3, sc in 5th ch of turning ch.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * across.

Rep Rows 2-5 for Pyramid St pattern.

Mesh Stitch Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, tr in next st, *3 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st; rep from * to turning ch-sp, tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5th ch of turning ch.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * across working last hdc in top of turning ch.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, tr in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 1, tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 2nd ch of turning ch. **Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, hdc in top of turning ch.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 3 and 4.

Rep Rows 5 and 6 for Mesh St pattern.

NOTES

- 1. Top is made from 4 pieces: Back, Front, and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included stitch diagrams.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

CORRECTIONS: (applied May 22nd, 2017)

BACK ... Shape Armholes...

Row 4: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern and change to A in last st – 2 dtr, 16 (20, 24) sc, 15 (19, 23) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

BACK

With A, ch 98 (114, 130).

Rows 1-12: Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Pyramid St pattern for 12 rows changing color as in following color sequence: Work first 4 rows with A, 6 rows with B, and 2 rows with C. Change to D in last st of last row – you will have 24 (28, 32) Pyramids in Row 1, 23 (27, 31) Pyramids in Row 11, and 25 (29, 33) sc and 24 (28, 32) ch-3 sps in Row 12.

Row 13 (Decrease Row – RS): With D, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, 2 tr in first ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 7 (9, 11) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 7 (9, 11) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in last ch-3 sp, tr in last st -93 (109, 125) tr.

Row 14: With D, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 47 (55, 63) hdc and 46 (54, 62) ch-1 sps.

Row 15: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch

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of turning ch – 23 (27, 31) Pyramids.

Row 16: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern and change to A in last st -2 dtr, 23 (27, 31) sc, 22 (26, 30) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 17 (Decrease Row – RS): With A, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 10 tr in next st, 10 times, tr in next st, 10 times, 10 tim

Rows 18-22: With A, work Rows 2-6 of Mesh St pattern and change to D in last st of Row 22 – 45 (53, 61) hdc and 44 (52, 60) ch-1 sps in Row 22.

Rows 23 and 24: With D, rep Rows 15 and 16 and change to C in last st of Row 24 – 2 dtr, 22 (26, 30) sc, 21 (25, 29) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps in Row 24.

Row 25 (Decrease Row – RS): With C, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 4 tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5th ch of turning ch = 85 (101, 117) tr.

Row 26: With C, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to A in last st – 43 (51, 59) hdc and 42 (50, 58) ch-1 sps.

Rows 27 and 28: With A, rep Rows 15 and 16 and change to C in last st of Row 28 – 2 dtr, 21 (25, 29) sc, 20 (24, 28) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps in Row 28.

Row 29 (Decrease Row – RS): With C, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 1 tr in next ch-3 sp) 5 (7, 9) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 1 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 4 tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st, 4 tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5 th ch of turning ch – 81 (97, 113) tr.

Rows 30-34: With C, work Rows 2-6 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st of Row 34 - 41 (49, 57) hdc and 40 (48, 56) ch-1 sps in Row 34.

Rows 35 and 36: With E, rep Rows 15 and 16 – 2 dtr, 20 (24, 28) sc, 19 (23, 27) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps in Row 36.

Fasten off.

Shape Armholes

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop of C in 2nd ch-3 sp, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in same ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 15 (19, 23) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp; leave rem sts unworked – 65 (81, 97) sts.

Row 2: With C, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 33 (41, 49) hdc and 32 (40, 48) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 16 (20, 24) Pyramids.

Row 4: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern – 2 dtr, 16 (20, 24) sc, 15 (19, 23) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

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Rows 5-9: Work Rows 1-5 of Mesh St pattern, changing color as in following sequence: Work first 4 rows with E, and last row with D.

Next 1 (3, 5) Rows: With D, beg with Row 4 of pattern work in Mesh St pattern for 1 (3, 5) rows and change to E in last st of last row – you will have 33 (41, 49) hdc and 32 (40, 48) ch-1 sps in last row.

Next Row: With E, rep Row 3 – 16 (20, 24) Pyramids. **Last Row:** With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern. Fasten off.

FRONT

Work same as Back until you have finished Row 32.

Left Front

Row 33 (RS): With C, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, tr in next ch-1 sp; rep from * 16 (20, 24) more times, tr in next st; leave rem sts unworked -20 (24, 28) tr and 17 (21, 25) ch-1 sps.

Row 34: With C, work Row 4 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 19 (23, 27) hdc and 18 (22, 26) ch-1 sps,

Row 35: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 9 (11, 13) Pyramids.

Row 36: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern – 2 dtr, 9 (11, 13) sc, 8 (10, 12) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Shape Armhole

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop of C in 2nd ch-3 sp, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in same ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 6 (8, 10) times, tr in next st, tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5th ch of turning ch – 29 (37, 45) tr.

Row 2: With C, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 15 (19, 23) hdc and 14 (18, 22) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch -7 (9, 11) Pyramids.

Row 4: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern – 2 dtr, 7 (9, 11) sc, 6 (8, 10) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Rows 5-8: With E, work Rows 1-4 of Mesh St pattern and change to D in last st of Row 8 - 15 (19, 23) hdc and 14 (18, 22) ch-1 sps.

Shape Neck

Row 9 (RS): With D, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next st, tr in next ch-1 sp) 8 (12, 16) times, tr in next st; leave rem sts unworked - 11 (15, 19) tr and 8 (12, 16) ch-1 sps.

Next 1 (3, 5) Rows: With D, beg with Row 4 of pattern work in Mesh St pattern for 1 (3, 5) rows and change to E in last st of last row – you will have 10 (14, 18) hdc and 9 (13, 17) ch-1 sps in last row.

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Next Row: With E, ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next ch-1 sp, *make Pyramid, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last sc in turning ch-sp - 4 (6, 8) Pyramids.

Last Row: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern. Fasten off.

Right Front

Row 33 (RS): From RS, sk 4 unworked ch-1 sps of Row 32 following Left Front, draw up a loop of C in next st, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next st, tr in next ch-1 sp; rep from * 16 (20, 24) more times, tr in top of turning ch - 20 (24, 28) tr and 17 (21, 25) ch-1 sps.

Row 34: With C, work Row 4 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 19 (23, 27) hdc and 18 (22, 26) ch-1 sps,

Row 35: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 9 (11, 13) Pyramids.

Row 36: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern and change to C in last st – 2 dtr, 9 (11, 13) sc, 8 (10, 12) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Shape Armhole

Row 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in first ch-1 sp, tr in next st, (3 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st) 6 (8, 10) times, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp; leave rem sts unworked – 29 (37, 45) tr.

Row 2: With C, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 15 (19, 23) hdc and 14 (18, 22) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 7 (9, 11) Pyramids.

Row 4: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern – 2 dtr, 7 (9, 11) sc, 6 (8, 10) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Rows 5-8: With E, work Rows 1-4 of Mesh St pattern for 4 rows – 15 (19, 23) hdc and 14 (18, 22) ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

Shape Neck

Row 9 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop of D in 6th hdc, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, tr in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sk next st, tr in next ch-1 sp) 7 (11, 15) times, ch 1, sk next st, tr in turning ch-sp, tr in next 2nd ch of turning ch – 11 (15, 19) tr and 8 (12, 16) ch-1 sps.

Next 1 (3, 5) Rows: With D, and beg with Row 4 of pattern work in Mesh St pattern for 1 (3, 5) rows and change to E in last st of last row – you will have 10 (14, 18) hdc and 9 (13, 17) ch-1 sps in last row.

Next Row: With E, ch 1, turn, sk first st, sc in next ch-1 sp, *make Pyramid, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last sc in turning ch-sp - 4 (6, 8) Pyramids.

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Last Row: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern. Fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With B, ch 42 (50, 58).

Rows 1-5: Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Pyramid St pattern for 5 rows changing yarn color as in following color sequence: Work first 4 rows with B then 1 row with C - 10 (12, 14) Pyramids in Row 5.

Row 6 (Increase Row – WS): With C, ch 8 (counts as dtr, ch 3), turn, sc in tip of first Pyramid, *ch 3, sc in tip of next Pyramid; rep from * to last sc, ch 3, dtr in last sc and change to D - 2 dtr, 10 (12, 14) sc, and 11 (13, 15) ch-3 sps.

Row 7: With D, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, *3 tr in next ch-3 sp, tr in next st; rep from * to turning ch-sp, 3 tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5th ch of turning ch – 45 (53, 61) tr.

Row 8: With D, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 23 (27, 31) hdc and 22 (28, 32) ch-1 sps.

Row 9: With E, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 11 (13, 15) Pyramids.

Row 10: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern and change to A in last st -2 dtr, 11 (13, 15) sc, 10 (12, 14) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Row 11 (Increase Row – RS): With A, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, 2 tr in first ch-1 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 10 (11, 12) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in turning ch-sp, tr in 5th ch of turning ch – 47 (55, 63) tr.

Rows 12-15: With A, work Rows 2-5 of Mesh St pattern – 25 (29, 33) tr and 22 (26, 30) ch-1 sps in Row 15.

Row 16 (Increase Row – WS): With A, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in first st (increase made), *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, 2 hdc in top of turning ch and change to D - 26 (30, 34) hdc and 23 (27, 31) ch-1 sps.

Row 17: With D, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *make Pyramid, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last sc in 2nd ch of turning ch - 12 (14, 16) Pyramids.

Rows 18-29: Rep Rows 6-17 changing color as in following sequence: Work next row with D, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 6 rows with C, and 1 row with E – 14 (16, 18) Pyramids in Row 29.

Row 30: With E, work Row 2 of Pyramid St pattern – 2 dtr, 14 (16, 18) sc, 13 (15, 17) ch-3 sps, and 2 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

Shape Cap (top of Sleeve)

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop of C in 2nd ch-3 sp, ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in same ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 9 (11, 13) times, tr in next st, 2 tr in next ch-3 sp; leave rem sts unworked - 41 (49, 57) tr.

Row 2: With C, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern and change to E in last st – 21 (25, 29) hdc and 20 (24, 28) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: With E, ch 1, turn, sl st in first st, sl st in next ch-1 sp, sc in next st, (make Pyramid, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next hdc) 9 (11, 13) times; leave rem sts unworked – 9 (11, 13) Pyramids.

Row 4: With E, turn, sk first st, sl st in each st to tip of first Pyramid, ch 1, sc in tip of first Pyramid, (ch 3, sc in tip of next Pyramid) 8 times – 9 (11, 13) sc and 8 (10, 12) ch-3 sps,

Row 5: With E, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, 2 tr in first ch-3 sp, (tr in next st, 3 tr in next ch-3 sp) 7 (9, 11) times – 31 (39, 47) tr.

Row 6: With E, work Row 2 of Mesh St pattern – 16 (20, 24) hdc and 15 (19, 23) ch-1 sps.

Row 7: With E, ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next hdc, tr in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next hdc, tr in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to turning ch-sp, sk next hdc, tr in 2nd ch of turning ch – 15 (19, 23) tr and 12 (16, 20) ch-1 sps.

Row 8: With E, ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 tr, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next tr, hdc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next tr, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp, sk next tr, hdc in top of turning ch - 12 (16, 20) hdc and 11 (15, 19) ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Note: The Back and Front have more rows than the Sleeve caps. Side edges of the extra rows at top of Back and Front are sewn to top edge of Sleeve cap. Sew in Sleeves. Sew Sleeve and side seams, leaving about 8 in. (20.5 cm) of sides unsewn for side slits.

Lower Edging

From RS and working along opposite side of foundation chains at lower edge, join A with sc any ch-3 sp of lower edge, 2 sc in same ch-3 sp, *work 3 sc in each ch-3 sp of lower edge to side slit, 3 sc in corner, work sc evenly spaced along both edges of side slit, 3 sc in corner; rep from * once more, 3 sc in each ch-3 sp to beg; join with sl st in first sc.

Sleeve Edging

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join A with sc on lower edge of Sleeve at seam, work an even number of sc evenly spaced along Sleeve edge; join with sl st in first sc. **Rnd 2:** Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), sk next st, hdc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st; rep from * to last st, ch 1, sk last st; join with sl st in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Fasten off.

Rep edging around 2nd Sleeve edge.

Neck Edging

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join E with sc at beg of left front neck, work sc evenly spaced down left front neck edge, across front neck, up right front neck edge and across back neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as tr), tr in each st down left front neck edge; sl st in center

of front neck edge (sk all other sts of front neck), tr in each st up right front neck edge; leave back neck edge unworked. Fasten off.

Tassels (make 2)

Wrap E around 4 in. (10 cm) cardboard about 60 times. Cut a 10 in. (25.5 cm) length of yarn and thread doubled into blunt needle. Draw needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly, knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut a 10 in. (25.5 cm) length of yarn and wrap tightly around loops 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot. Knot, then thread ends into needle and weave into center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. With 2 strands of E held together, make a chain about 15 in. (38 cm) long. Fasten off. Tie on end of chain to top of Tassel, other end of chain to one corner of Front neck.

Weave in yarn ends.
