**Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick®-  
Vanna's Choice®-Vanna's Glamour®  
First Frost Convertible Cowl**  
**Pattern Number: L50357**



## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

### **SIZE**

**Finished Circumference** About 114 in. (289.5 cm)

**Finished Height** About varies from about 5-9 in. (12.5-23 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Art. #792)
  - 211 Granite Stripes 1 skein (A)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
  - 105 Silver Blue 1 ball (B)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour® (Art. #861)
  - 150 Platinum 1 ball (C)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

6 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with A and larger hook.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

### **NOTES**

1. Cowl is worked in 3 easy steps, following a diagram.
2. Each step of the Cowl uses a different yarn.
3. The Cowl was designed to wrap multiple times around your neck.

### **COWL**

#### **Step 1**

With A and larger hook, ch 36.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 35 hdc.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across to beg ch, hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

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## Step 2

Choose either side of the Cowl to be the RS.

From RS, with smaller hook and following diagram, join B with a sl st to one end of Cowl.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, work 23 sc evenly spaced across 7 in. (18 cm) section of Cowl.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next 2 sts, (ch 3, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, ch 3, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts) twice – Three 3-dc groups, two 3-sc groups, and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 dc, (ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next 3 sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 dc) twice working last sc in top of beg ch-3 – Three 3-sc groups, two 3-dc groups, and 4 ch-3 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first sc, dc in next 2 sc, (ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 dc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next 3 sc) twice.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until Step 2 piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm), end with a Row 4 as the last row you work.

Fasten off.

## Step 3

From RS, with smaller hook and following diagram, join C with a sl st to end of Cowl opposite Step 2.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, work 16 sc evenly spaced across 5 in. (12.5 cm) section of Cowl.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next st, ch 3, sk next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts, ch 3, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, ch 3, sk next 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts – One 3-dc group, one 3-sc group, one 2-dc group, one 2-sc group, and 3 ch-3 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first sc, dc in next sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 dc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, dc in next 3 sc, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next dc, sc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 3 until Step 3 piece measures about 50 in. (127 cm).

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew sides of Step 1 section tog, leaving 3 in. (7.5 cm) open at top edge.

Sew end of Step 2 section to end of Step 3 section, easing Step 2 section to fit.

Weave in ends.
