

# Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Shawl in a Ball Granny Afghan/Shawl Pattern Number: L60129



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### SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 45 x 45 in. (114.5 x 114.5 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Shawl in a Ball (Art. #828)
  - 201 Restful Rainbow 1 ball (A)
  - 204 Healing Teal 2 balls (B)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

## **GAUGE**

Rnds 1-4 = about 4 1/2 x 4 1/2 in. (11.5 x 11.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### NOTE

Afghan/Shawl is worked in one piece in joined and turned rnds.

## AFGHAN/SHAWL

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (Right Side):** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 1, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have 4 ch-1 sps and four 3-dc groups in this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Turn, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in first ch-1 sp (first corner made), \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made); rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 corner ch-1 sps and eight 3-dc groups (two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

**Rnd 3:** Turn, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc) in first sp between 3-dc groups, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; rep from \* 2 more times, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in last corner ch-1 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 4 corner ch-1 sps and twelve 3-dc groups (three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

**Rnd 4:** Turn, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc) in first sp between 3-dc groups, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice; rep from \* 2 more times, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in last sp between 3-dc groups; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 corner ch-1 sps and sixteen 3-dc groups (four 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps). **Rnds 5-23:** Turn, (sl st, ch 3, 2 dc) in first sp between 3-dc groups, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner ch-1 sp, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner



ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner ch-1 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 corner ch-1 sps and ninety-two 3-dc groups (twenty-three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps) at the end of Rnd 23.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 24:** From Wrong Side, join B with a sl st in first sp between 3-dc groups following any corner ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner ch-1 sp, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner ch-1 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to end of rnd; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 4 corner ch-1 sps and ninety-six 3-dc groups (twenty-four 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps). **Rnds 25-40:** With B, rep Rnd 5 sixteen times – 4 corner ch-1 sps and one hundred-sixty 3-dc groups (forty 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps) at the end of Rnd 40.

**Rnd 41:** Turn, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in first sp between 3-dc groups, \*ch 3, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in next sp between 3-dc groups or next corner ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ch 3; join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

rasten on.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
