SKILL LEVEL - Beginner

SIZE

About 8 x 42 in. (20.5 x 106.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Tonal (Art. #635)
 - 102 Aqua 1 ball (A)
 - 154 Grey Marble 1 ball (B)
 - 109 Royal Blue 1 ball (C)
 - or colors of your choice
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver™ Starter Kit
- Martha Stewart Crafts™/MC Lion Brand® Yarn DIY Weaver Extender™ Kit



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Button, 1 in. (2.5 cm) in diameter
Sewing needle and thread

NOTES

1. Two identical pieces are woven, one for each half of the Scarf. Each piece is woven using the same warp set up and each has the same number of rows.
2. The warp is set up in stripes, following manual instructions for Warping. The weft is woven in stripes, following manual instructions for Basic Weaving.
3. To change yarn color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail. Begin weaving with the new color, leaving a long yarn tail. These tails will be woven in later.
4. The 2 halves of the Scarf are sewn together.

Loom Set-Up

Following DIY Weaver Extender™ kit manual instructions, connect loom base from starter kit to loom base from extender kit.

Insert 22 standard pegs along bottom and top edges of loom bases – 44 pegs placed for warp.

SCARF HALF (make 2)

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 44 pegs as follows:

8 pegs with C, 28 pegs with B, 8 pegs with C.

Weft

Following the weaver manual instructions for Basic Weaving, weave the weft changing color as follows:

12 rows with A
7 rows with B
18 rows with A
4 rows with C
18 rows with A
7 rows with B
12 rows with A
7 rows with B
9 rows with C

Repeat last 94 rows.

With C, weave the remainder of the warp.

FINISHING

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

With tapestry needle threaded with A, sew halves together.

Weave in yarn ends.

Button Loop

Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) strand of C and fold in half. Knot strand about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from fold. With tapestry needle, sew ends of loop to one long edge of Scarf about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from short end.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button to opposite long edge of Scarf at corner.
