**Mountain Cabin Afghan**

## **SKILL LEVEL - Easy**

## **SIZE**

About 50 x 50 in. (127 x 127 cm) not including border

## **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice (Art. #860)
  - 104 Pink Grapefruit 1 ball (A)
  - 139 Rose Shocking 1 ball (B)
  - 301 Rose Mist 1 ball (C)
  - 112 Raspberry 1 ball (D)
  - 180 Cranberry 1 ball (E)
  - 148 Burgundy 1 ball (F)
  - 303 Purple Mist 1 ball (G)
  - 145 Eggplant 1 ball (H)
  - 158 Mustard 1 ball (I)
  - 109 Colonial Blue 1 ball (J)
  - 300 Denim Mist 1 ball (K)
  - 111 Sky Blue 1 ball (L)
  - 183 Periwinkle 1 ball (M)
  - 107 Sapphire 1 ball (N)
  - 176 Peacock 1 ball (O)
  - 108 Dusty Blue 1 ball (P)
  - 172 Kelly Green 1 ball (Q)
  - 171 Fern 1 ball (R)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

## **GAUGE**

16 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## **STITCH PATTERNS**

**Seed St (worked over an even number of sts)**

**Row 1 (WS):** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st worked over an even number of sts.

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**Seed St (worked over an odd number of sts)**

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end of row.

**Row 2:** K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st worked over an odd number of sts.

**NOTES**

1. 25 Blocks are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram.
2. Each Block begins with a Center, then 8 Logs are worked around the Center.
3. When working with 2 colors, carry the yarn color not in use up the side edge of the piece until next needed.
4. A border is worked across each outside edge of the Afghan.
5. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts on the border. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

**GENERAL BLOCK INSTRUCTION**

**Note:** Follow the instructions below to make each Block, changing color following the Color Chart.

**Center**

With straight needles and 1st color, cast on 20 sts.

**Rows 1 and 2:** With 1st color and beginning with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

**Rows 3 and 4:** With 2nd color, knit.

**Rows 5-32:** Rep Rows 1-4.

**Rows 33 and 34:** Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Bind off.

**1st Log**

Turn Center clockwise.

From RS with 3rd color, pick up and k20 sts evenly spaced across side edge of Center.

Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st for 3 rows.

Bind off.

**2nd Log**

From RS with 4th color, pick up and k22 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 1st Log and cast-on edge of Center.

Work as for 1st Log.

Bind off.

**3rd Log**

From RS with 5th color, pick up and k22 sts evenly spaced across side edges of 2nd Log and Center.

Work as for 1st Log. Bind off.

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#### **4th Log**

From RS with 6th color, pick up and k24 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 3rd Log, bound-off edge of Center and side edge of 1st Log.

Work as for 1st Log.

Bind off.

#### **5th Log**

From RS with 7th color, pick up and k24 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 4th Log, bound-off edge of 1st Log and side edge of 2nd Log.

With 7th color, work Row 1 of Seed st worked over an even number of sts.

With 8th color, work in Seed st for 2 rows.

With 7th color, work in Seed st for 2 rows.

Rep last 4 rows once more.

Bind off.

#### **6th Log**

From RS with 7th color, pick up and k29 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 5th Log, bound-off edge of 2nd Log and side edge of 3rd Log.

Beg with Row 1, work in Seed st worked over an odd number of sts for 11 rows.

Bind off.

#### **7th Log**

From RS with 9th color, pick up and k30 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 6th Log, bound-off edge of 3rd Log and side edge of 4th Log.

**Row 1 (WS):** With 9th color, purl.

With 10th color, knit 2 rows.

With 9th color, work 2 rows in St st.

Rep last 4 rows 2 more times.

Bind off.

#### **8th Log**

From RS with 10th color, pick up and k39 sts evenly spaced across side edge of 7th Log, bound-off edge of 4th Log and side edge of 5th Log.

Beg with Row 1, work in Seed st worked over an odd number of sts for 9 rows.

Bind off.

### FINISHING

Following diagram, sew blocks into 5 strips of 5 blocks each. Sew strips together to make Afghan.

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## **Border**

**First Side:** From RS with circular needle and P, pick up and k200 sts evenly spaced across one side of Afghan. Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

**Second Side:** From RS with circular needle and Q, pick up and k202 sts evenly spaced across side edge of first side border and next side of Afghan. Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

**Third Side:** From RS with circular needle and J, pick up and k202 sts evenly spaced across side edge of second side border and next side of Afghan. Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

**Fourth side:** From RS with circular needle and M, pick up and k204 sts evenly spaced across side edge of third side border, next side of Afghan, and edge of first side border. Knit 3 rows.

Bind off.

Weave in ends.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
