<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Size

About 4 x 6 in. (10 x 15 cm), not including trims.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 104 Pink Grapefruit 1 ball (A)
 - 106 Aquamarine 1 ball (B)
 - 183 Periwinkle 1 ball (C)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® Hometown®

(Art. #135)

- 100 New York White 1 ball (D)
- 158 Pittsburg Yellow 1 ball (E)
- 109 Fort Worth Blue 1 ball (F)
- 102 Honolulu Pink 1 ball (G)
- 106 Maui Aqua 1 ball (H)
- or colors of your choice
- Martha Stewart Crafts^{™MC} Lion Brand[®] Yarn DIY Weaver[™] Starter Kit



Twigs (natural or artificial)

Assorted beads as desired (with holes large enough to accommodate the tapestry needle)

NOTES

- The Wall Hangings are meant to inspire your creativity! Follow the row by row instructions to make each Hanging, though you needn't follow the pattern exactly.
- 2. Each Wall Hanging has embellishments and beads as trim. Instructions are given for each technique to embellish as desired.
- To change yarn color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail. Begin weaving with the new color, leaving a long yarn tail. These tails will be woven in later.
- 4. The manual includes most of the information you need to complete your Wall Hanging and be sure to visit Lionbrand.com for step by step videos of DIY WeaverTM techniques.



Loom Set-Up

Following manual instructions, insert 12 standard pegs across the top row of the loom base and 12 pegs 17 rows directly below – 24 pegs placed for warp.

WALL HANGING 1

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 24 pegs with B.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

With F, weave 5 rows.

With D, weave 7 rows.

With E, weave 2 rows.

With A, weave 9 rows.

With E, weave 3 rows.

With F, weave 8 rows.

With D, weave the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

WALL HANGING 2

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 24 pegs with A.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

With G, weave 12 rows.

With B, weave 8 rows.

With H, weave 14 rows.

With A, weave 6 rows.

With E, weave the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

WALL HANGING 3

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 24 pegs with B.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows: With E, weave 10 rows.

With F, weave 7 rows.

With H, weave 2 rows.

With D, weave 12 rows.

With E, weave 4 rows.

With H, weave 1 row.

With E, weave 4 the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

WALL HANGING 4

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 24 pegs with A.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

With F, weave 10 rows.

With G, weave 10 rows.

With D, weave 8 rows.

With C, weave the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

WALL HANGING 5

Warp

Following manual instructions for Warping, set up the warp across 24 pegs with B.

Weft

Following manual instructions for Basic Weaving, work as follows:

With H, weave 5 rows.

With F, weave 2 rows.

With H, weave 5 rows.

With C, weave 6 rows.

With H, weave 5 rows.

With D, weave 5 rows.

With F, weave 2 rows.

With C, weave 12 rows.

With H, weave the remainder of the warp.

Remove Weaving From Loom

Carefully lift all the loops up and off the pegs.

FINISHING

Fringe

Following the video instructions for adding fringe to your weaving, add fringe with colors of your choice. If desired, thread ends of fringe into tapestry needle, then draw needle through a bead or beads. Knot fringe end below bead.

Pom-poms

Following the video instructions for making pom-poms, insert embellishment pegs into the loom base about 1 to 2 in. (2.5 to 6 cm) apart, or as desired. With yarn color as desired, make 1 large and 2 small pom-poms.

To mix 2 yarn colors in a pom-pom, hold 2 strands of yarn together to make the pom-pom.

Trim pom-poms, leaving one long yarn tail untrimmed.

Thread the long yarn tail into the tapestry needle, then string beads as desired onto the tail.

Tie the yarn tails onto the bottom edge of Hanging.

Tassels

Following the video instructions for making tassels, insert embellishment pegs into the loom base about 4 to 6 in. (10 x 15 cm) apart, or as desired.

With yarn colors as desired, make tassels.

Trim tassels, leaving one long yarn tail untrimmed.

Thread the long yarn tail into the tapestry needle, then string beads as desired onto the tail.

Tie the yarn tails onto the bottom edge of Hanging.

Attach Hanging to Twig

Thread tapestry needle with a strand of yarn in color as desired. Knot end of strand to the top of the Hanging.

Hold the twig against the top edge of the Hanging. Loop the yarn over the twig then through the top edge of the Hanging until the Hanging is fully attached to the twig. Knot yarn.

Hanger

Thread tapestry needle with a 16 in. (40.5 cm) strand of yarn in color as desired. Knot end of strand. String beads as desired onto strand, then knot remaining end of strand.

Tie ends of strand to ends of twig.

With tapestry needle, weave yarn ends into back of the Hanging.
