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SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

<u>SIZES</u>

S/M (L/1X)

Finished Bust About 40 (48) in. (101.5 (122) cm)

Finished Length About 23 1/2 (59.5 cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® 24/7 Cotton(Art. #761)
 - 153 Black 3 (4) balls (A)
 - 110 Navy 1 (2) ball(s) (B)
 - 144 Magenta 1 (1) ball(s) (C)
 - 147 Purple 1 (1) ball(s) (D)
 - 142 Rose 1 (1) ball(s) (E)
 - 113 Red 1 (1) ball(s) (F)
 - 172 Grass 1 (1) ball(s) (G)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

14 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm). 1 Granny Square = about 4 x 4 in. (10 x 10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.



<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Pullover is made from 4 pieces: Back, Front, and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. Back and Front are each made from 25 (30) Granny Squares sewn together following Assembly Diagrams. Shoulders are worked, back and forth in rows, across top edge of assembled squares.
- 3. Each Granny Square is worked in joined rnds with RS always facing.
- 4. To change yarn color when making Granny Squares, fasten off old color and join new color as instructed. If yarn color is not changed between rnds, do not fasten off, simply sl st in each st to the next corner ch-2 sp and then continue as if you had just joined a new color.
- 5. Change yarn color when making shoulders and Sleeves, as follows:
 - a. To change yarn color from A to B, work last st of A to last yarn over. Yarn over with B and draw up through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with B. Do not fasten off A. Not fastening off A will reduce the number of yarn ends to weave in later.
 - b. To change yarn color from B to A. Fasten off B. Do not turn work. From RS, insert hook in first st of previous row, yarn over with dropped strand of A and draw up a loop.
- 6. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram for the Granny Square.

GRANNY SQUARE I (make 2)

With C, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 3 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) twice, ch 2, 2 dc in ring; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—you will have four 3-dc groups and 4 ch-2 spaces.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, draw up a loop of E in any ch-2 sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—eight 3-dc groups, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps. Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, draw up a loop of F in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 2 dc in first corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—twelve 3-dc groups, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps.

Fasten off. Rnd 4: From RS, draw up

Rnd 4: From RS, draw up a loop of D in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), 3 dc in same ch-2 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 2 dc in first corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—sixteen 3-dc groups, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps. Fasten off.

Rnd 5: From RS, join A with sc in any corner ch-2 sp, (2 sc, ch 2, 3 sc) in same ch-2 sp, *(ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, (3 sc, ch 2, 3 sc) in next

corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 sc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1; join with sl st in first sc—twenty 3-sc groups, 16 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps. Fasten off.

GRANNY SQUARE II (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnds 1 and 2, E for Rnd 3, C for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE III (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using B for Rnd 1, G for Rnd 2, B for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE IV (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnds 1 and 2, D for Rnd 3, G for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE V (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnd 1, G for Rnd 2, E for Rnd 3, B for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE VI (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using F for Rnd 1, B for Rnd 2, D for Rnd 3, B for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE VII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using E for Rnds 1-3, G for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE VIII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using E for Rnd 1, C for Rnds 2 and 3, F for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE IX (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnd 1, C for Rnd 2, A for Rnd 3, E for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE X (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnd 1, A for Rnd 2, G for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XI (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnd 1, G for Rnd 2, C for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using E for Rnd 1, F for Rnd 2, G for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XIII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using A for Rnd 1, C for Rnd 2, E for Rnd 3, G for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XIV (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnd 1, D for Rnds 2 and 3, G for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XV (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnds 1 and 2, E for Rnd 3, C for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XVI (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using B for Rnd 1, D for Rnd 2, G for Rnd 3, E for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XVII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using G for Rnd 1, C for Rnds 2-4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XVIII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using E for Rnds 1 and 2, G for Rnd 3, E for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XIX (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using B for Rnd 1, G for Rnds 2 and 3, D for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XX (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using G for Rnd 1, F for Rnd 2, A for Rnd 3, B for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXI (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using F for Rnd 1, E for Rnds 2 and 3, D for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using G for Rnds 1 and 2, D for Rnd 3, E for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXIII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using A for Rnd 1, B for Rnd 2, F for Rnd 3, G for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXIV (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using G for Rnd 1, A for Rnd 2, E for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXV (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnd 1, D for Rnds 2-4, and A for Rnd 5.

SIZE L/1X ONLY

Note: Only make Granny Squares XXVI-XXX if you are making size L/1X. **GRANNY SQUARE XXVI (make 2)**

Make same as Granny Square I, using F for Rnd 1, B for Rnd 2, C for Rnd 3, D for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXVII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using D for Rnd 1, C for Rnd 2, B for Rnd 3, F for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXVIII (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using B for Rnd 1, F for Rnds 2 and 3, C for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXIX (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnd 1, B for Rnd 2, F for Rnds 3 and 4, and A for Rnd 5.

GRANNY SQUARE XXX (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, using C for Rnd 1, D for Rnd 2, F for Rnd 3, B for Rnd 4, and A for Rnd 5.

ASSEMBLY

Following Assembly Diagrams, sew Granny Squares into 10 (12) strips of 5 Squares each. Sew 5 (6) strips together for Front and 5 (6) strips together for Back.

Front Shoulders

From RS, join A with sl st in upper right corner of Front.

Row 1 (RS): With A, ch 1, work 73 (87) sc as evenly spaced as possible along top edge of Front – 73 (87) sc.

Row 2: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * across and change to B in last st -37 (44) sc and 36 (43) ch-1 sps. Drop, but do not fasten off, A.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc and ch-1 sp across – 73 (87) sc. Fasten off B.

Row 4 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, sc in same st and in each st across.

Row 5: With A, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, 2 sc in last st and change to B in last st – 39 (46) sc and 36 (43) ch-1 sps. Drop, but do not fasten off, A.

Row 6: With B, ch 2 (counts as hdc), sk first st, hdc in each ch-1 sp and sc across - 75 (89) hdc.

Fasten off B.

Row 7 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, 2 sc in same st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st – 77 (91) sc.

Row 8: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * across and change to B in last st -39 (46) sc and 38 (45) ch-1 sps. Drop, but do not fasten off. A.

Left Shoulder

Row 9 (RS): With B, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, (sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next st) 10 (13) times, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc2tog; leave rem sts unworked – 24 (30) sc. Fasten off B.

Row 10 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 23 (29) sc. **Row 11:** With A, ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, ch 1, sk next st, 2 sc in last st - 13 (16) sc and 10 (13) ch-1 sps.

Row 12: With A, ch 1, turn, sl st in first 8 sts, sc in next 4 (6) sts, hdc in next 4 (6) sts, dc in next 4 (6) sts, dc3tog – 13 (19) sts (not including sl sts). Fasten off.

Right Shoulder

Row 9 (RS): From RS, sk next 28 (30) unworked sts of Row 8, join B with sl st in next st, ch 1, beg in next st, sc2tog, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st – 24 (30) sc.

Fasten off B.

Row 10 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, beg in first st, sc2tog, sc in each st across – 23 (29) sc.

Row 11: With A, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 13 (16) sc and 10 (13) ch-1 sps.

Row 12: With A, ch 3, turn, dc2tog (beg ch-3 and following dc2tog count as one dc3tog). dc in next 4 (6) sts, hdc in next 4 (6) sts, sc in next 4 (6) sts, sl st in last 8 sts – 13 (19) sts (not including sl sts).

Fasten off.

Back Shoulders

From RS, join A with sl st in upper right corner of Back. Rows 1-8: Work same as Rows 1-8 of Front Shoulders. **Row 9:** With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across – 77 (91) sts. Fasten off B. Row 10 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, sc in each st across. Left Shoulder

Row 11 (WS): With A, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 10 (13) times, sc2tog; leave rem sts unworked -13 (16) sc and 10 (13) ch-1 sps. **Row 12:** With A, ch 3, turn, dc2tog (beg ch-3 and following dc2tog count as one dc3tog), dc in next 4 (6) sts, hdc in next 4 (6) sts, sc in next 4 (6) sts, sl st in last 8 sts -13 (19) sts (not including sl sts).

Fasten off.

Right Shoulder

Row 11 (WS): From WS, sk next 30 (32) unworked sts of Row 10, join A with sl st in next st, ch 1, beg in next st, sc2tog, sc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) 9 (12) times, ch 1, sk next st, 2 sc in last st – 13 (16) sc and 10 (13) ch-1 sps. **Row 12:** With A, ch 1, turn, sl st in first 8 sts, sc in next 4 (6) sts, hdc in next 4 (6) sts, dc3tog – 13 (19) sts (not including sl sts). Fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

With A, ch 44 (50).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 43 (49) sc.

Row 2: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * across and change to B in last st -22 (25) hdc and 21 (24) ch-1 sps. Drop, but do not fasten off, A.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each sc and ch-1 sp across – 43 (49) sc. Fasten off B.

Row 4 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, sc in each st across.

Row 5: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * across and change to B in last st. Drop but do not fasten off A.

Row 6: With B, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each sc and ch-1 sp across.

Fasten off B.

Row 7 (RS): Change to A, ch 1, sc in each st across.

Rows 8-10: Rep Rows 2-4.

Rows 11-15: With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 16 (Increase Row): With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, (sc in next 20 (23) sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 46 (52) sc.

Rows 17-33: Rep Row 11 seventeen times.

Row 34 (Increase Row): With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, (sc in next 21 (24) sts, 2 sc in next st) twice, sc in last st - 49 (55) sc. **Rows 35-43:** Rep Row 11 nine times.

Row 44 (Increase Row): With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, (sc in next 23 (26) sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 52 (58) sc.

Rows 45-53: Rep Row 11 nine times.

Row 54 (Increase Row): With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 24 (27) sts) twice, 2 sc in last st – 55 (61) sc. **Rows 55-59:** Rep Row 11 five times.

Do not fasten off.

Shape Cap (upper portion of Sleeve)

Row 60 (WS): With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, sl st in first 4 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, dc in next 31 (37) sts, hdc in next 5 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sl st in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 47 (53) sts (not including sl sts).

Row 61: With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, sk first sl st, sl st in next st, sc in next 9 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, dc in next 17 (23) sts, hdc in next 5 sts, sc in next 9 sts, sl st in next st; leave rem st unworked – 45 (51) sts (not including sl sts).

Row 62: With A and working in front loops only, ch 1, turn, sk first sl st, sl st in next 7 sts, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 6 sts, dc in next 11 (17) sts, hdc in next 6 sts, sc in next 4 sts, sl st in next st; leave rem sts unworked -31 (37) sts (not including sl sts).

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulders. Place markers on Front and Back side edges about 8 1/2 (9 1/2) in. (21.5 (24) cm) down from shoulder seams. Sew Sleeves between markers.

Neck Edging

From RS, join A with sl st in neck edge at right shoulder seam. **Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work 35 (37) sc as evenly spaced as possible across back neck and 51 (53) sc across front neck; join with sl st in first sc – 86 (90) sc. **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, *ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last st, ch 1, sk last st; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Sew side and Sleeve seams. Weave in ends.
