

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand[®] Vanna's Choice[®] London Calling Scarf Pattern Number: L60174



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 9 1/2 x 74 in. (24 x 188 cm), not including fringe

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Vanna's Choice® (Art. #860)
 - 109 Colonial Blue 1 ball (A)
 - 145 Eggplant 1 ball (B)
 - 158 Mustard 1 ball (C)
 - 125 Taupe 1 ball (D)
 - 134 Terracotta 1 ball (E)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

Six 2-dc groups + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTES</u>

- 1. Scarf is worked back and forth in rows, changing yarn color to make stripes and blocks of color.
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. If the color change is at the end of a row, fasten off the old color. If the color change is in the middle of a row, drop the old color and pick it up again when making the color change in the next row.
- 3. For those who find visuals helpful, we've included a stitch diagram and a color diagram.

<u>SCARF</u>

With A, ch 32.

Beg Stripe Section

Row 1: Work 2 dc in 5th ch from hook, 2 dc in next ch, *sk next 2 ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have fourteen 2-dc groups and 1 dc at each end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, *sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

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Rows 3-18: Rep Row 2, changing color as in following stripe sequence: Work 2 more rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with E, and 4 rows with A. Change to B in last st of Row 18.

First Color Block Section

Row 19: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 3 times, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to C; with C, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) twice, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 20: With C, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to B; with B, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 4 times, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 21-34: Rep Rows 19 and 20 seven times. Change to A in last st of Row 34.

Rows 35-38: With A, rep Row 2 four times. Change to D in last st of Row 38.

Second Color Block Section

Row 39: With D, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to E; with E, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 4 times, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 40: With E, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 3 times, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to D; with D, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) twice, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 41-48: Rep Rows 39 and 40 four times. Do not change color in last st of Row 48.

Rows 49-64: Rep Row 2 changing color as in following stripe sequence: work 6 rows with D, 4 rows with A, and 6 rows with B. Change to C in last st of Row 64.

Third Color Block Section

Row 65: With C, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 3 times, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to B; with B, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) twice, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 66: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to C; with C, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 4 times, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 67-74: Rep Rows 65 and 66 four times. Change to A in last st of Row 74. **Rows 75-78:** With A, rep Row 2 four times. Change to E in last st of Row 78. **Fourth Color Block Section**

Row 79: With E, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and

change to D; with D, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 4 times, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 80: With D, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) 3 times, sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st and change to E; with E, 2 dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts) twice, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 81-94: Rep Rows 79 and 80 seven times. Change to A in last st of Row 94.

Last Stripe Section

Rows 95-108: Rep Row 2, changing color as in following stripe sequence: Work 4 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with C, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with D, 2 rows with E, and 4 rows with A.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 13 in. (33 cm) strands of all yarn colors. For each fringe, hold 3 strands of the same color yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 15 fringes along each of the 2 short ends of Scarf, with 3 strands in each fringe, and using colors as in following sequences and shown in color diagram: (1 fringe each of A, E, D, B, and C) 3 times evenly spaced along one short end and (1 fringe each of A, C, B, D, and E) 3 times evenly spaced along other short end. Trim fringe evenly.

Weave in ends.
