



***Free Knitting Pattern***  
**Lion Brand® Scarfie®**  
**Thunderstorm Scarf**  
Pattern Number: L60171



## **SKILL LEVEL** - Easy

### **SIZE**

About 8 x 60 in. (20.5 x 152.5 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Scarfie® (Art. #826)
  - 201 Cream/Black 1 ball
  - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



### **GAUGE**

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern.  
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

### **STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

#### **s2kp2 (slip 2-knit-pass 2 slipped sts over)**

1. Insert right hand needle as if to knit into the second and then the first st on the left hand needle, then slip both sts together to the right hand needle.
2. Knit the next st.
3. With tip of left hand needle, lift the 2 slipped sts (the 2nd and 3rd st on the right hand needle) up and over the knit st (the first st on right needle) and off the needle – 2 sts decreased.

#### **yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

### **NOTES**

1. Scarf is worked in one piece.
2. The first stitch of every row is slipped. You can choose to slip as if to knit or slip as if to purl – whichever looks best with your style of knitting.

### **SCARF**

Cast on 31 sts.  
Knit 2 rows.

### **Begin Pattern**

**Row 1:** Slip 1, k4, \*yo, s2kp2, yo, k3; repeat from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Rows 2 and 3:** Slip 1, knit to end of row.

**Row 4:** Slip 1, purl to end of row.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until about 1 yd. (1 m) of yarn remains, end with a Row 3 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

st(s) = stitch(es)
