

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand[®] Hometown USA[®] Calliope Super Scarf Pattern Number: L60196



SKILL LEVEL - Easy

<u>SIZE</u>

About 10 x 112 (25.5 x 284.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Hometwon USA® (Art. #135)
 - 114 Tampa Spice 1 ball (A)
 - 111 San Diego Navy 1 ball (B)
 - 108 Washington Denim 1 ball (C)
 - 112 Miami Seafoam 1 ball (D)
 - 308 Key Largo Tweed 1 ball (E)
 - 175 Montpelier Peacock 1 ball (F)
 - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand[®] crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle

<u>GAUGE</u>

2 pattern reps = about 4 3/4 in. (12 cm). **Note:** One pattern rep consists of 1 ch-5 sp or ch-7 sp and the following sc. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

<u>NOTE</u>

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
- 2. The yarn color is changed following a Stripe Sequence.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
- 4. When instructions tell you to work in a chain space "2 rows below" this means the chain space is in the row numbered 2 less that the current row. For example, if you are working Row 5, a chain space "2 rows below" is in Row 5 2 = Row 3.
- 5. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 5 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 4 rows with A, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 8 rows with E, 8 rows with F, 6 rows with A.



<u>SCARF</u>

With A, ch 26.

Row 1: With A, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 5, sk next 5 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across – you will have 5 sc and 4 ch-5 sps (4 pattern reps) in this row. **Row 2:** With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to end of row.

Row 3: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to end of row – 5 sc and 4 ch-7 sps.

Row 4: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to end of row.

Row 5: With A, ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, insert hook under next ch-7 sp 2 rows below and work a sc to bind the ch-7 sps of the previous 2 rows together, *ch 5, insert hook under next ch-7 sp 2 rows below and work a sc; rep from * to last sc, ch 2, dc in last sc and change to B - 4 sc, 2 dc, 3 ch-5 sps and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 6: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next sc, *ch 5, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 2, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-5 – 6 sc, 3 ch-5 sps and 2 ch-2 sps.

Row 7: With B, ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, sk next ch-2 sp, sc in next sc, *ch 7, sk next ch-5 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to last ch-2 sp, ch 3, sk last ch-2 sp, dc in last sc – 4 sc, 2 dc, 3 ch-7 sps and 2 ch-3 sps.

Row 8: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 3, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in next sc, *ch 7, sk next ch-7 sp, sc in next sc; rep from * to turning ch-sp, ch 3, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-6 – 6 sc, 3 ch-7 sps and 2 ch-3 sps.

Row 9: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 5, insert hook under ch-7 sp 2 rows below and work a sc; rep from * to last ch-3 sp, ch 5, sc in last sc.

Rows 10-161: Rep Rows 2-9 nineteen times and continue to change color following Stripe Sequence.

Rows 162-165: Rep Rows 2-5 and continue to change color following Stripe Sequence.

Rows 166 and 167: Rep Row 6 twice and continue to change color following Stripe Sequence.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
