

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Color Waves Iris Super Scarf Pattern Number: L60187



# **SKILL LEVEL** - Beginner

#### SIZE

**Finished Size** About 10 x 160 in. (25.5 x 406.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Color Waves (Art. #595)
  - 222 Playground 2 balls (A)
  - 216 Rainbow 2 balls (B)
  - 206 Marble 2 balls (C)
  - 214 Newsprint 2 balls (D)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



#### **GAUGE**

16 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### NOTE

Scarf is worked in one piece with 2 strands of yarn held together, changing one of the yarn colors every 40 in. (101.5 cm).

## **SCARF**

With 1 strand each of A and B, cast on 40 sts.

Row 1: \*Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from \* across the row.

Repeat Row 1 until Scarf measures about 40 in. (183 cm) from beginning.

Change to 1 strand each of B and C.

With 1 strand each of B and C, repeat Row 1 until Scarf measures about 80 in. (203 cm) from beginning.

Change to 1 strand each of A and D.

With 1 strand each of A and D, repeat Row 1 until Scarf measures about 120 in. (305 cm) from beginning.

Change to 1 strand each of C and D.

With 1 strand each of C and D, repeat Row 1 until Scarf measures about 160 in. (406.5 cm) from beginning.

#### Bind off as follows:

With 1 strand each of C and D, k1, p1, pass first st on right hand needle over second st on right hand needle to bind off 1 st, k1, bind off 1 st, p1, bind off 1 st; continue in this way until all sts are bound off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
