

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Color Waves Theia Super Scarf Pattern Number: L60186



## SKILL LEVEL - Easy

## SIZE

About 10 x 116 in. (25.5 x 294.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- Lion Brand® Color Waves (Art. #595)
  - 214 Newsprint 2 balls (A)
  - 203 Deep Blue Sea 2 balls (B)
  - 206 Marble 1 ball (C)
  - or colors of your choice
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



#### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

## **GAUGE**

16 sts + 25 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Seed st. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

#### yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

Seed St (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of row.

Row 2: P the knit sts and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece in 2 sections.
- 2. Stitches for the second section are picked up from the first section.
- A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts on the second section. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.
- 4. Slip (sl) sts as if to knit.

- 5. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row; with yarn in back (wyib) refers to the side of the work that is away from you as you work the row.
- To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.

## **SCARF**

### **First Section**

With A, cast on 26 sts.

Rows 1-39: With A, work in Seed st for 39 rows.

Rows 40-43: With B, knit 4 rows.

Row 44 (RS): With A, knit.

Rows 45-49: With A, work in Seed st for 5 rows.

**Rows 50-59:** Rep Rows 40-49. **Rows 60-64:** Rep Rows 40-44.

Rows 65-704: Rep Rows 1-64 for 10 more times.

Rows 705-743: With A, work in Seed st for 39 rows.

Bind off.

#### **Second Section**

**Tip:** To pick up sts evenly spaced along a long edge, use pins or removable st markers to divide the long edge into equal sections.

In this case, if you divide the long edge into 10 sections, you can simply pick up and knit 45 sts in each of 6 sections and 46 sts in the remaining 4 sections.

From RS with B, pick up and k454 sts as evenly spaced as possible along left edge of First Section.

Rows 1 and 2: With B, knit.

**Row 3 (WS):** With B, \*k26, (yo, k1, yo, k5) twice, yo, k1, yo; rep from \* to last 25 sts, k25.

**Row 4:** With C, \*k25, (drop next yo, sl 1 wyib, drop next yo, sl 1 wyib, k4) twice, (drop next yo, sl 1 wyib) twice; rep from \* to last 25 sts, k25.

**Row 5:** With C, \*work in Seed st over 25 sts, (sl 2 wyif, work in Seed st over next 4 sts) twice, sl 2 wyif; rep from \* to last 25 sts, work in Seed st over last 25 sts.

**Row 6:** With C, \*work in Seed st over 25 sts, (sl 2 wyib, work in Seed st over next 4 sts) twice, sl 2 wyib; rep from \* to last 25 sts, work in Seed st over last 25 sts.

Row 7: With C, rep Row 5.

Rows 8-10: With B, knit.

Row 11: With B, rep Row 3.

**Rows 12-15:** With C, rep Rows 4-7.

Rows 16-23: Rep Rows 8-15.

Rows 24-26: With B. knit 3 rows.

With B, bind off as if to knit.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

wyib = with yarn in back

wyif = wit yarn in front

WS = wrong side
